RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt The Following Resolutions:

- 1) Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator, Or Designee, To Award A Construction Contract To McGuire And Hester, Inc., The Lowest Responsible, Responsive Bidder In Accordance With Project Plans And Specifications For The Lakeside Green Streets Project (Project No. C393910) And With Contractor's Base Bid In The Amount Of Nine Million Four Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand, Six Hundred One Dollars (\$9,428,601.00) And Authorize The City Administrator To Increase The Same Construction Contract By The Amount Of Two Million Two Hundred Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars (\$2,202,632.00) For A Total Contract Amount Not-To-Exceed Eleven Million Six Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$11,631,233.00) As Additional Funds Become Available.
- 2) Resolution Waiving The Competitive Request For Proposal/Qualification Process And Authorizing An Amendment To Increase The As-Needed Landscape Architectural Services Agreement With Placeworks (Formerly Design Community And **Environment) By An Amount Not-To-Exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars** (\$250,000.00), Bringing The Total Contract Amount From Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000.00) To One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000.00).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of these two resolutions will authorize the City Administrator or Designee to execute a construction contract with McGuire and Hester in the amount of \$9,428,601.00 and increase the same construction contract by the amount of \$2,202,632.00 for the inclusion of bid alternates A and C for a total contract amount not-to-exceed \$11,631,233.00, when Measure DD, Series C funds become available. The City Administrator or Designee will also be authorized to increase the professional service agreement with PlaceWorks for landscape architectural services by an amount not-to-exceed two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) to provide additional design and construction support services for the Measure DD Lakeside Green Streets Project for contingencies and any unforeseen conditions that may occur during the construction phase.

The project was born out of the Lake Merritt Master Plan and initiated as part of the Measure DD, Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks Bond. The project will enhance a major multimodal travel corridor through road reconfiguration that will provide traffic calming, increased bicycle and pedestrian facilities, expanded park space at Snow Park and Lake Merritt Park and storm water treatment facilities along the shore of Lake Merritt. The work is located in Council District 3 as shown in *Attachment A*.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The Lakeside Green Streets Project is located along the northwest side of Lake Merritt from Madison Street and Lakeside Drive up to Harrison Street and Grand Avenue. The project was developed as part of the Lake Merritt Master Plan and initiated through Measure DD, Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks Bond approved by voters in November 2002.

The project is designed to expand park space at Lake Merritt and Snow Park, improve pedestrian access to Lake Merritt, and provide new bike lanes and storm water treatment facilities along Harrison Street and Lakeside Drive.

The project includes new pedestrian entries to Lake Merritt at all cross street locations with new accessible access nodes and pathways that lead to the lakeside trail. A portion of 20th Street will be vacated and replaced with a pedestrian promenade expanding Snow Park and connecting pedestrians to the Lake via a new mid-block crossing at Lakeside Drive from the new pedestrian promenade to Lake Merritt.

Construction Contract Award: McGuire and Hester is a certified LBE contractor. They bid the project as a prime and have been deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in accordance with the project plans and specifications.

PlaceWorks Landscape Architectural Professional Service Contract Expansion: On March 2, 2010, City Council approved Resolution No. 82558 C.M.S. awarding an as-needed landscape architectural services contract to PlaceWorks for an amount not-to-exceed \$500,000.00. On January 24, 2012, City Council approved Resolution No. 83700 C.M.S. increasing the PlaceWorks as-needed landscape architectural services contract in the amount of \$350,000.00 to provide additional design services for the Lakeside Green Streets Project.

In March of 2013, the City received two grants totaling \$9,200,000.00 from One Bay Area Federal Transportation Grant and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission for the Lakeside Green Streets Project. With the award of the \$9,200,000.00 in Federal funding, additional design services were required to meet the federal authorization process and to restore several design elements that were omitted in the initial design due to lack of funding. As the project moves into construction, construction support services are required for the project to meet particular Federal requirements as well additional design services may be required for design revisions and unforeseen site conditions. As a result, an amendment to the previous consultant services contract is necessary to support the completion of the project.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

Construction Contract Award: On May 12, 2016, the City Clerk received two (2) bids for this project as shown below:

The City Administrator's Office, Contracts and Compliance Division established that both bidders met the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal and are EBO (Equal Benefits Ordinance) compliant as shown on *Attachment B*: Compliance Analysis, dated June 3, 2016. As determined by the Compliance Analysis, McGuire & Hester is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Under the proposed contract with McGuire & Hester, the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation will be 22.7%, which exceeds the project DBE goal of 19%. The DBE information has been verified by the Social Equity Division of the City Administrator's Office, Contracts and Compliance Division and is shown in *Attachment B*.

Construction is scheduled to begin in November 2016 and is estimated to be complete by spring 2018. The contract specifies \$2,800.00 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract is not completed within 400 working days.

PlaceWorks Landscape Architectural Professional Service Contract Expansion: The City Administrator's Office, Contracts and Compliance Division conducted a compliance analysis for the referenced project. As shown in **Attachment C**: Compliance Analysis, Request For Proposals for As Needed Landscape Architectural Services-Including Amendment No. 2, dated June 9, 2016, PlaceWorks shows 62% L/SLBE participation, exceeding the minimum requirement.

FISCAL IMPACT

Approval of this Resolution will authorize the City Administrator to execute a construction contract in the amount of \$9,428,601.00 and increase the professional services agreement by an additional \$250,000.00. As additional funds become available from Measure DD, Series C

The Measure DD funds for the inclusion of bid alternates A and C will be provided upon the bond sale of Measure DD, Series C, which is scheduled for Fall 2016.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

McGuire and Hester provided satisfactory service for the Coliseum BART Plaza and Pedestrian Areas Project, completed in 2013 and for the 12th Street Reconstruction and Improvements Project. PlaceWorks (DC&E) ranked "Satisfactory" overall for the Oakland Waterfront Trail 66th Avenue Improvements which was completed in 2008.

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

The public input process for this project began in early 2011 with a series of public meetings to gather input on the design of this project. This included two public meetings held specifically for this project that were publicized to the general public in the spring of 2011 and a week of setting an information table at the Kaiser Center during the lunch hour where written comments and surveys were collected. Additionally, the design team presented the project concept and 65% design at number of standing public meetings including the Measure DD Community Coalition, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, the Bike and Pedestrian Advisory Commission, the Public Art Commission and to the Downtown and Uptown Business Districts. The City maintains updated project information on the City of Oakland Measure DD webpage at www.oaklandnet.com/measuredd.

Additionally, 80 days of public noticing and comment periods were provided in association with obtaining National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) clearance and City of Oakland Conditional Use and Tree Removal Permits. During this period there were signs posted at the site indicating the scope of the improvement project and the 20 trees identified for removal were posted and tagged.

COORDINATION

The work to be done under this contract has been coordinated with the Oakland Parks and Recreation Department, appropriate divisions within the Public Works Department and Contract and Compliance Division.

This report and the resolutions have been reviewed for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and have been reviewed by the Controller's Bureau.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The park, roadway, and pedestrian improvements will enhance parcels adjacent to the project area. The water efficiency gained by a modern irrigation system and drought-tolerant, native vegetation will reduce water costs. In addition, the awarded contract and services provides business opportunities for local material firms and suppliers.

Environmental: The Lakeside Green Streets Project is a Low Impact Development (LID), complete streets and water quality improvement project. The project will reduce impervious roadway surface along the shoreline of Lake Merritt, add new bio-infiltration and retention facilities by expanding existing park land and providing storm water treatment to 4.0 acres of impervious surfaces. An additional 2.0 acres of lawn and impervious surfaces will be converted to drought tolerant, Bay Friendly and native plant landscaping. Buffered bike lanes will be added on Harrison Street and Lakeside Drive.

Social Equity: Lake Merritt and Snow Park serve a diverse community of residents and regional visitors. The project will improve recreation and educational opportunities for residents, visitors, and school groups. The project features, including new pedestrian pathways and a renovated restroom, are ADA accessible.

CEQA

The Lakeside Green Streets Project has received California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) clearance under the City of Oakland Measure DD Implementation Project Environmental Impact Report, June 2008, State Clearinghouse# 2006122048. A project-specific CEQA Addendum was completed in November 2014.


A: Project Location Map

WHEREAS, PlaceWorks, formerly Design Community and Environment, was chosen through the City's Request-for-Proposal process to provide landscaping architectural services for City of Oakland projects on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2010, the City Council approved Resolution No. 82558 C.M.S. awarding an as-needed landscape architectural services contract to PlaceWorks (Design, Community and Environment) in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Lakeside Green Streets Project is identified in the Lake Merritt Master Plan for improvements and funds are available for the project through Bond Measure DD, The Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks; and

WHEREAS, staff utilized the contract with PlaceWorks for the Measure DD Lakeside Green Streets Project to commence the programming/planning, survey, schematic design, design development, and preparation of construction documents; and

WHEREAS, in March of 2013, staff applied for and was awarded a One Bay Area Federal Transportation Grant in the amount \$7,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, upon award of the \$9,200,000.00 in federal funding, additional design services were required to complete the federal authorization process and to include several additional design elements that were not included in the initial design due to lack of funding; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to continue utilizing PlaceWorks as the project moves into the construction phase for additional construction support services, contingency for unforeseen conditions and potential additional design services that may occur during the construction of the project; and

WHEREAS, funding for the design services of the Lakeside Green Streets Project within Amendment No. 2 is available from the Measure BB Fund (2216), Capital Project Management Organization (92270), Consultant Services Account (54411) in Lakeside Green Streets Project (C491230); and
