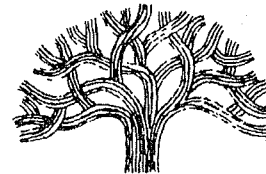

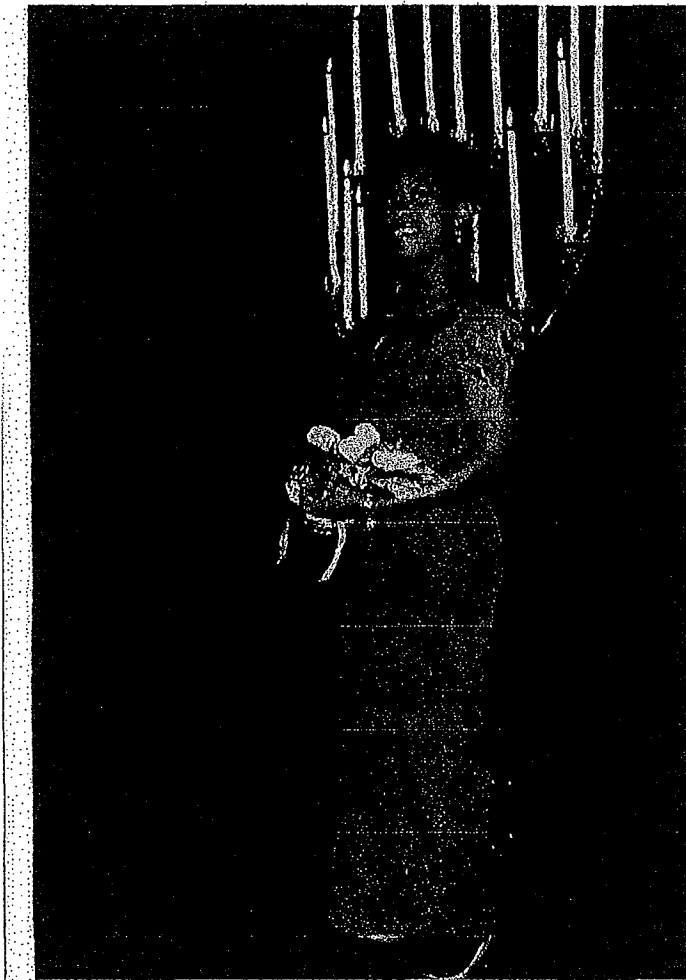

Preet Anand, for a three-year term beginning October 19, 2014 and ending October 18, 2017, filling the seat previously held by Phyllis Stevenson; and
