RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF *LAMAR GREEN V. CITY OF OAKLAND,* ALAMEDA COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. RG15775898, CITY ATTORNEY'S FILE NO. 30605, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$28,000.00) (OAKLAND PUBLIC WORKS – DANGEROUS CONDITION)

WHEREAS, Plaintiff Lamar Green alleges that he sustained injuries resulting from a trip and fall on a pothole in the roadway on 10th Street in Oakland on March 6, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Plaintiff filed the above-referenced action to recover monetary damages; and

WHEREAS, without admitting fault or wrongdoing, the City has determined to compromise and settle Plaintiff's claims against it for the sum of Twenty-Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$28,000.00); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of *Lamar Green v. City of Oakland*, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG15775898, City Attorney's File No. 30605, for a sum not to exceed Twenty-Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$28,000.00) payable by the City of Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps necessary to effect said settlement.
