## RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Accept This Informational Report With Information Regarding Internal Affairs Investigations, Police Personnel Trainings, Updates To Police Policy, And Recent Developments In Police Discipline.

## REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

At the November 15, 2016 Public Safety Committee meeting, staff was asked to provide additional information concerning Internal Affairs Investigations – specifically:

- The number of cases investigated for failure to supervise last five years
- The number of times discipline was sustained for failure to supervise last five years
- The overall number of Internal Affairs cases for previous years
- The overall number of Internal Affairs allegations for previous years

Failure to Supervise: Cases and Discipline Imposed 2011-2016

For the period of January 1, 2011 through November 15, 2016, the total number of cases investigated that involved an allegation of failure to supervise is 66. For the period of January 1, 2011 through November 15, 2016, the number of <u>cases allegations</u> in which discipline was imposed for failure to supervise is 31. The table below provides an annual breakdown.
