**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO CYBER COMPUTERS INC, THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHTY-DOLLARS AND ONE CENT (\$386,080.01) TO PURCHASE MICROCOMPUTERS, DESKTOP AND TOWER-BASED SYSTEMS, AND MONITORS FOR A PERIOD OF NINE (9) MONTHS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SPECIFICATION NO. 17-204-53/ REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) 6175,1.**

**WHEREAS,** Additional and replacement computer systems and monitors are required for departments to perform their day-to-day operations; and

**WHEREAS,** On August 10, 2016, in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code (OMC) 2.04.050A, the city issued and advertised Specification 17-204-53/ RFQ No. 6175,1 to provide Microcomputers, Desktop and Tower-Based Systems, and Monitors to cover this need for new and replacement computers and monitors; and

**WHEREAS,** On August 29, 2016 the City Clerk received and opened one bid in response to Specification No. 17-204-53/ RFQ 6175,1 to provide Microcomputers, Desktop and Tower-Based Systems, and Monitors; and

**WHEREAS,** The bid submitted by Cyber Computers Inc. was deemed to be the lowest responsible and responsive bidder and meets all of the requirements contained in Specification No. 17-204-53 / RFQ 6175,1;

**WHEREAS,** Funds will be encumbered by various City departments' existing budgets, as needed, from requests submitted to the Information Technology Department (ITD) for processing; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to award a contract to Cyber Computers Inc., the lowest responsible and responsive bidder to purchase Microcomputers, Desktop and Tower-Based Systems and Monitors, for a period of nine (9) months, in an amount up to three hundred eighty-six thousand eighty-dollars and one cent (\$386,080.01) in accordance with Specification No. 17-204-53,1; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that department funds will be encumbered by various City departments' existing budgets, as needed, from requests submitted to the Information Technology Department for processing; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Council hereby rejects all other bids submitted in the response to RFQ No. 17-204-53; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Office of the City Attorney will review and approve the contract as to form and legality and a copy shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
