ORDINANCE REPEALING CURRENT OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 15.12, THE OAK-LAND FIRE CODE, MAKING FINDINGS TO SUB-STANTIATE MODIFICATIONS TO CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODES AND STANDARDS DUE TO LO-CAL CLIMATIC, GEOLOGICAL OR TOPOGRAPHI-CAL CONDITIONS, AND ADOPTING AND MAK-ING LOCAL AMENDMENTS TO THE 2016 EDI-TION OF THE CALIFORNIA MODEL BUILDING CODE, CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS TI-TLE 24, PART 9, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION ASSOCIA-TION AND OTHER REFERENCED STANDARDS AS ADOPTED BY THE CALIFORNIA STATE FIRE MARSHAL, AND RECODIFYING SAID CODE AS OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 15.12, THE OAKLAND FIRE CODE

The California Model Fire Code established the minimum standards and uniform administrative guidelines for Fire Safety standards throughout the state. This ordinance will provide findings required to substantiate modifications of the California Building Codes and standards due to local climatic, geological or topographical conditions and adopt existing and new regulations in the Oakland Municipal Code that will amend the 2016 edition of the California Fire Code. The amendments will provide supplemental administrative and technical requirements pertinent to the City's building inventory, topography, geology, infrastructure needs, and health and safety require-

This California model Fire code with local amendments shall be effective and implemented on January 1, 2017, or on the date the ordinance is filled with the California Building Standards Commission, whichever date is later, and shall be the governing codes of the City of Oakland.
