AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 13184 C.M.S. (THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016 MASTER FEE SCHEDULE) TO (A) SUPPORT THE CITY'S DEMAND-RESPONSIVE PARKING MANAGEMENT INITIATIVES WITH (1) VARIABLE PRICING OF ON-STREET METER RATES AND (2) OFFSTREET PARKING FACILITY RATES THAT REFLECT THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DOWNTOWN OAKLAND PARKING MANAGEMENT REPORT; AND (B) ESTABLISH FEES FOR A DEDICATED SPACE CARE SHARING PROGRAM

Staff is recommending changes to Ordinance Number 13184 C.M.S. (The Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Master Fee Schedule) to support parking and mobility initiatives. Recommended changes include (1) an increase in the maximum hourly parking rate that can be charged in actively managed flexible parking zones and increases to hourly and monthly parking fees at City-owned garages and lots; and (2) the creation of fees to support the dedicated space car sharing program. Additional changes have been made with the aim of simplifying rate structures and consolidating all fees related to car sharing in a new section dedicated to that program.
