ORDINANCE (1) REPEALING THE OAKLAND AMENDMENTS TO THE 2013 EDITION OF THE CALIFORNIA MODEL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION CODES, (2) ADOPTING LOCAL AMENDMENTS TO THE 2016 EDITION OF THE CALIFORNIA MODEL BUILDING CONSTRUCTION CODES, AND (3) AMENDING OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 15.04 TO COMPLY WITH CHANGES TO STATE LAW AND ADOPTING CEQA EXEMP-TION FINDINGS

The California Model Building Construction Codes establish minimum technical standards and uniform administrative guidelines for construction of residential and non-residential buildings and structures throughout the state. This ordinance will re-adopt existing Oakland amendments of the state statutes that provide supplemental administrative guidelines and technical regulations pertinent to the City's building inventory, topography, geology, infrastructure needs, and life/safety requirements. These Oakland amendments are substantially the same as those adopted by the City for previous editions of the model codes.

The 2016 editions of the California Model Building Construction Codes with Oakland amendments become effective on January 1, 2017, and shall be the governing building construction codes of the City of Oakland.
