
 This is the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Report on park conditions by the Foundation and its former affiliate, Oakland Parks Coalition.


 112 parks, medians and public landscaped areas were surveyed in the fall of 2016 by park stewards and neighborhood park group volunteers.

#### **Survey Category Averages**






#### **Survey Ratings**

Points were weighted: A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0

This year's Park Overall average was 2.51, equivalent to a C, and essentially no different from the 2.5 average in 2015.

#### Park Maintenance Staffing History






