RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH UNITY SCHOOLS FOR THE PREIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2016 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2017 TO ALLOW THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT (OPD) TO USE UNITY SCHOOLS' PREMISES FOR TRAINING PURPOSES

WHEREAS, OPD operates its own police officer training academies to ensure that new police officer trainees (POT) are prepared for demanding police work; and

WHEREAS, OPD requires diverse training facilities beyond what is available in the police administration building (PAB) to ensure that sworn personnel and new police officer trainees have opportunities to train in such areas as canine pursuits and tactical operations; and

WHEREAS, the Unity High School is a public charter high school located in East Oakland, which has acquired a multi-floor building for its new campus; and

WHEREAS, the Unity High School administration is not yet not prepared to move its instructional operations to this new building for approximately two years, and is therefore willing to allow OPD training personnel to use the building in this interim period for scenario training; and

WHEREAS, this building provides a great benefit to OPD training personnel because the design and layout of the multi-floor structure with different interior environments are an ideal training environment for OPD's Canine Program, Tactical Team, and other police academy training needs; and

WHEREAS: Oakland City Charter Section 504(I) requires the City Adminstrator to obtain council approval when negotiating contracts for joint governmental actions; and

WHEREAS, OPD and Unity Schools have agreed that the training shall not involve the use of live ammunition, bombs, gas, smoke or "flash bang" distraction devices, detonations and/or any other similar device or activity; and

WHEREAS, OPD and Unity Schools have agreed that the training shall not interfere with the operation or use of the Property by any tenants or by Licensor or cause any damage to any structures, fixtures, buildings, landscaping and/or other

improvements on the Property; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or designee, to enter into Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Unity Schools for personnel training purposes, from October 1, 2016 until September 30, 2017; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend this MOU without returning to the City Council; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall review and approve said MOU with Unity Schools as to form and legality, and a copy of the fully executed agreement shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.
