WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed Alicia Contreras subject to confirmation by the City Council; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601 the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's following appointment to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities:

Alicia Contreras, Mayoral appointment to serve the remainder of a three-year term that began September 3, 2015 and end September 2, 2018, filling the seat previously held by Elise Bernstein.
