

**ADOPT A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY REGARDING THE VISITING PROFESSIONAL INITIATIVE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland Department of Transportation was approached by the Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) with a Visiting Professional Initiative (Initiative) in October 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, the CTA's Initiative is a professional development opportunity intended to provide peer learning and knowledge exchange between CTA and other city transportation and transit agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, through the Department of Transportation's Strategic Plan, the City has articulated goals to plan and implement fast, frequent, reliable transit and to improve interagency coordination with partner transit agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the CTA's Visiting Professional Initiative offers an opportunity for the City of Oakland to benefit from the expertise of a Senior Manager for Business Strategic Planning at the Chicago Transit Authority to implement these goals; and

**WHEREAS**, the Initiative will have no fiscal impact on the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the MOU shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council directs the City Administrator to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Chicago Transit Authority regarding the Visiting Professional Initiative; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the term of this Initiative will be from March 6, 2017 to March 5, 2018; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said Memorandum, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney.


