**WHEREAS,** Public Safety Telecommunicators of the Oakland Fire and Oakland Police Departments have contributed substantially to the suppression of fires, treatment of patients, and apprehension of criminals; and

WHEREAS, our dispatchers exhibit compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their duties; now, therefore be it
