## INTRODUCED BY MAYOR LIBBY SCHAAF

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF DWAYNE AIKENS AND AMY COLE TO THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 8065 C.M.S., adopted November 13, 1969 and amended by Ordinance No. 11731 C.M.S., adopted July 26, 1994, establishes the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission to advise the Mayor, City Council, City Administrator and the Office of Parks and Recreation on all matters relating to the general policy and operation of the parks and recreation system; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission consists of eleven (11) members serving no more than two consecutive three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed Dwayne Aikens and Amy Cole to serve three-year terms, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointments of:

**Dwayne Aikens,** to serve a three-year term on the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission beginning November 17, 2014 and ending November 16, 2017, filling the seat previously held by Barry Miller; and

**Amy Cole,** to serve a three-year term on the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission beginning November 14, 2014 and ending November 13, 2017, filling the seat previously held by Cyril Manning.
