## **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) FOR ANY COMPETITIVE GRANT FOR WHICH THE CITY OF OAKLAND IS ELIGIBLE**

**WHEREAS,** the granting agency, CalRecycle requires that any application for CalRecycle grant funding be accompanied by an authorization from the applicant's governing body; and

WHEREAS, the State of California enacted the Budget Act of 2016 (AB 1613) which appropriated \$40 million for CalRecycle to invest in programs that divert organics from landfill; and

**WHEREAS,** CalRecycle grant programs for which City staff would apply, support the City's Zero Waste goals and the Zero Waste Strategic Plan, which rely on programs that divert organics from landfill; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted the City's Zero Waste goals and the Zero Waste Strategic Plan through Resolution No. 80286 C.M.S. in November 2005; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle issues other grant opportunities which support Oakland's strategic goals such as elimination of illegal dumping;

WHEREAS, it is in the City of Oakland's best interest to be able to apply for any and all grant opportunities CalRecycle makes available and that Oakland is eligible; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to submit applications to California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for any competitive grant for which the City of Oakland is eligible; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution shall be filed with the City Clerk.
