## RECOMMENDATION

**Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt:** 

A Resolution Awarding A Security Services Contract To ABC Security Services Inc. For A Term Period Of Three (3) Years With An Option To Extend The Contract Upon Satisfactory Completion Of The Initial Term In Increments Of One (1) Year; For Up To A Total Of Two (2) Consecutive Additional Years: In An Amount Not-To-Exceed Two Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) For Each Year Of The Contract; OR

Adopt A Resolution Awarding A Security Services Contract To Cypress Security Services Inc. For A Term Period Of Three (3) Years With An Option To Extend The Contract Upon Satisfactory Completion Of The Initial Term In Increments Of One (1) Year; For Up To A Total Of Two (2) Consecutive Additional Years; In An Amount Not-To-Exceed Two Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) For Each Year Of The Contract.

# **ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES**

## **Interview Scoring Summary and Method**

The oral interviews consisted of a Question and Answer session to include four categories of questions. The first section consisted of 10 questions that were tailored to identify the bidders Work History, Experience, and Management, with a maximum of 40 points possible from each of the (3) raters. The second section consisted of 10 questions that were tailored to identify the bidder's Operations and Technical abilities, with a possible maximum of 30 points from each of the three (3) raters. Section three consisted of 3 situational questions where each firm could earn a maximum of 10 points for each question with a combined maximum of 30 points

possible. The final section was the presentation and sample incident report which was valued at 15 points from each rater for a total maximum of 45 points.

The interview scoring process was based on a 100-point value, with the combined points from each question a firm could earn 115 actual points from each of the three (3) raters, for a maximum total of 345 "actual" points. The sum of each firm's actual points for the interview questions was divided by 1.15 to give a maximum 100-point value. To determine the final rank and score, the total number (from the 100-point value column) was divided by three for the average score. Bidders were eligible to receive additional earned credits for Local/Small Local Business Enterprises (L/SLBE) Participation. If the bidders meet the eligibility requirements for the L/SLBE those points were added to the average score for the final score and rank for the interviews.

**Table A** below shows the specific categories of questions from the formal interviews, the combined scores from the raters, the earned points for L/SLBE participation and the final rank.

# **ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL**
