

RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator, Or Designee, To Award A Professional Services Contract To Harrison Engineering Inc., In The Amount Of Two Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$220,000), For The Preparation Of Construction Documents For The Highway Safety Improvement Program, Cycle 7 (HSIP7), Market Street And San Pablo Avenue Project, In Accordance With The Federal Grant Consultant Selection Process.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of this resolution will authorize the City Administrator to execute a professional services contract with Harrison Engineering Inc., in the amount of \$220,000 for design of pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements on San Pablo Avenue and Market Street under the HSIP Cycle 7 project. The selection process is based on the requirements for federally funded projects. The project is in Council District 3 as shown in *Attachment A*.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) is a competitive federal grant program that provides funds to improve safety on roadways for all modes of transportation. In July 2015, the City submitted four grant proposals for HSIP Cycle 7 (HSIP7) that included Market Street and San Pablo Avenue, for safety and operational improvements for pedestrians, bicycles and vehicular traffic. The grant selection process was based on cost effective measures that could reduce the potential for collisions, especially those that result in severe injuries or fatalities. Caltrans approved Market Street and San Pablo Avenue HSIP7 proposal as well as the proposals at three other locations that include Claremont Avenue and Shattuck Avenue; Downtown (intersections on Oak, Jackson, Harrison, Franklin, 12th Streets); and Telegraph Avenue. Resolution No. 86027 C.M.S., accepting the grants for all four HSIP7 projects, was passed on February 10, 2017. The other three HSIP7 projects are being designed in-house.

The Market Street and San Pablo Avenue HSIP7 Project, Project No. 1003204, is recommended for design by Harrison Engineering Inc. The project site limits are Market Street between 4th Street and 21st Streets; and San Pablo Avenue between 32nd Street and 34th Streets. The proposed bicycle safety improvements include installation of striping and signage, bicycles lanes gap closure, right-turn lane separation striping, green skip-striping, safe transitioning of bicycle lanes and refreshing of faded bicycle lane. The pedestrian safety improvements include rectangular rapid flashing beacons, corner bulb-outs, sidewalks widening, refuge median island, traffic signals modification to eliminate vehicle and pedestrian conflicts.

The project will enhance mobility and accessibility for pedestrians and bicycles, and improve safety for all users. It will reduce potential conflicts, collisions, and severity of collisions. All improvements are consistent with both the Pedestrian and Bicycle Master Plans, as well as Oakland's Complete Street Policy, and the new "Vision Zero" paradigm.

ANALYSIS & POLICY ALTERNATIVES

The project is funded by a federal grant. The selection of professional services firm is competitive and qualifications-based in compliance with consultant selection procedures for federally funded projects. The proposals were evaluated and ranked without consideration of consultant fee, in accordance with the federal requirements. The Request for Proposal (RFP) was advertised on May 26, 2017. On June 29, 2017, the City received proposals from five firms. They are ranked below:

A panel of three transportation professionals, one from an outside agency and two from the City of Oakland, evaluated the proposals, in accordance with the federal selection guidelines. The following federal grant evaluation criteria were used:

- Understanding of the work to be done.
- Experience with similar kinds of projects.
- Quality of staff for work to be done.
- Capability of developing innovative or advanced techniques.
- Familiarity with state and federal procedures.

- Financial responsibility.
- Demonstrated technical ability.

The City Administrator's Office, Contracts and Compliance Unit deemed all the five bidders as responsive and responsible as shown on *Attachment B*. Since this project is federally funded, the City's LBE/SLBE programs are not applicable, and therefore, proposals meet the Federal DBE goals of 6.00% required for this HSIP7 project. Harrison Engineering Inc. is ranked first, and is a responsive and responsible bidder. Harrison Engineering Inc. is recommended for award in accordance with federal guidelines.

PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

During the HSIP7 grant application phase, staff reached out and coordinated with stakeholders including Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART), AC Transit, Bike East Bay (a bicycle advocacy organization), and the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC). The City received letters of support from some of these stakeholders. The letters were submitted to Caltrans as a part of the grant proposals.

COORDINATION

The Office of the City Attorney and the Controller's Bureau have reviewed this report and resolution. The deliverables under these contracts will be reviewed and coordinated with:

- California Department of Transportation (Caltrans)
- OPW Infrastructure Maintenance Division
- DOT Electrical Services Division
- Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC)
- Bike East Bay

FISCAL IMPACT

The total project cost is \$1,584,300. Federal grant is \$1,425,870, and the local match is \$158,430. For the design phase, federal grant is \$150,000 and local match is \$70,000.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

Harrison Engineering Inc. does not have past projects with the City.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: This project will improve transportation conditions and make the Market Street and San Pablo Avenue corridors safer, easier to navigate, and more attractive. The project improvements will enhance the efficiency and affordability of the transportation network and increase the potential for economic and housing development in the neighborhood. Furthermore, future construction contract will create job opportunities for residents through the City's LBE/SLBE contracting requirements.

Environmental: The project will provide a safer route for pedestrians and bicyclists in the Market Street and San Pablo Avenue corridors thereby providing a more attractive alternative to automobile travel. During construction, the project will implement the Best Management Practices for the protection of storm water runoff during construction to prevent pollutants from entering the storm drain systems.

Social Equity: The project will result in greater mobility, accessibility and safety to pedestrians, bicycles, non-motorized modes, and will support persons with disabilities, ADA compliant accessibility and children, to access schools, jobs, recreational facilities and other services.



WHEREAS, on July 31, 2015, the City of Oakland submitted grant proposal under Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 7 for the Market Street and San Pablo Avenue Project; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 86027 C.M.S., accepting the grant, was passed March 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, preliminary assessments were conducted on all project sites to address safety, access and mobility, and to identify countermeasures to address deficiencies; and
