President Reid and Members of the City Council:

Pursuant to Section 401 of the City Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing the compromise and settlement of the above-entitled action. Due to the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances settlement is recommended in the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) payable to Plaintiff Olga Cortez.

On December 7, 2015 Ms. Cortez alleges that inebriated off-duty Oakland police officers came to her home and assaulted her in front of her children and husband. Ms. Cortez also alleged civil rights violations in connection with investigative efforts by responding OPD officers. This settlement will resolve all claims against the City in this matter.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, February 20, 2018 (moved by Councilmember Kaplan and seconded by Councilmember Brooks – 6 Ayes, 1 No – Guillen and 1 Absent – Campbell-Washington).

WHEREAS, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case Olga Cortez, et al. v. City of Oakland, et al, CV-16-06256-JSW for the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement.
