RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AN OPERATIONAL AREA AGREEMENT WITH ALAMEDA COUNTY TO CREATE AN INTERMEDIATE LEVEL OF THE STATE EMERGENCY SERVICES ORGANIZATION THAT WILL COMPLY WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA STANDARDIZED EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (SEMS) FOR THE PERIOD FROM MAY 10, 2016 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, the potential for a major catastrophe due to natural or human-caused disaster causes all government entities within Alameda County to be prepared to share resources and information among themselves as well as with the State of California in order to protect public welfare; and

WHEREAS, greater efficiency and disaster preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation can be achieved by joining the efforts of the County of Alameda, other cities, special districts, and other public benefit non-profit corporations together in pre-disaster agreements; and

WHEREAS, the California Emergency Services Act makes reference to the "operational area" and defines it as "an intermediate level of the state emergency services organization" created to perform extraordinary functions for local governments within a county area such as strengthening mutual coordination, providing a focal point and conduit for disaster information, and assisting in the efficient management of resources; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2006, the Oakland City Council approved Resolution No. 79704 C.M.S. which adopted the Operational Area Agreement and authorized Oakland's participation in the Alameda County Operational Emergency Management Organization; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 Operational Area Agreement expired December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2016, the Alameda County Board of Supervisors re-ratified a new ten-year agreement and invited the cities and other political subdivisions within the county to once again participate in the Alameda County Operational Area Emergency Management Organization; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council adopts the Agreement for Participation in Alameda County Operational Area Emergency Management Organization, as it was approved by the Alameda County Board of Supervisors on May 10, 2016 and authorizes the City Administrator to enter into that agreement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator designate, in writing, the following:

- 1) Three persons who will be provided training and orientation to the policies and procedures so that they may represent the city to the Operational Area Emergency Management Organization; and
- 2) A line of succession of officials (minimum of three persons) who are empowered to represent the city to the Operational Area Emergency Management Organization; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator provide these two lists to the Alameda County Operational Area Emergency Management Organization within thirty (30) days of adoption of this resolution; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That this agreement will be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


