Pursuant to Section 401 of the City Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing the compromise and settlement of the above-entitled action. Due to the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances settlement is recommended in the sum of Seventy Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$75,000.00) payable to Plaintiff Laura Miller and her attorneys, Joseph W. Campbell and Thomas G. Lewellyn.

This action arises from an incident on December 3, 2016, wherein Ms. Miller tripped and fell on a sidewalk defect on 8<sup>th</sup> Street adjacent to the Lake Merritt BART station in Oakland.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, March 20, 2018 (moved by Councilmember Lynette Gibson McElhaney and seconded by Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan - 7 Ayes, 1 Absent – Councilmember Dan Kalb).
