("SAL-ARY ORDINANCE") TO PROVIDE WAGE IN-CREASES TO REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES PUR-SUANT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDER-STANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND THE SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATION-AL UNION, LOCAL 1021; THE WAGE INCREASES SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS: INCREASE OF 1% EFFEC-TIVE THE FIRST PAY PERIOD IN JANUARY 2019; ADDITIONAL INCREASES OF 1% EFFEC-TIVE THE FIRST PAY PERIOD IN JANUARY 2019; ADDITIONAL INCREASES OF 1% OR SE-LECT LISTED CLASSIFICATIONS EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018; ADDITIONAL INCREASE OF 7% FOR SELECT LISTED CLASSIFICATIONS EF-FECTIVE THE SECOND PAY PERIOD FOLLOW-ING OAKLAND CITY COUNCL'S RATIFICATION OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATION-AL UNION, LOCAL 1021; AND ADDITIONAL IN-CREASES OF UP TO 2% FOR SELECT LISTED CLASSIFICATIONS EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018.

This Ordinance will provide wage increases in This Ordinance will provide wage increases in the classifications and associated wages list-ed in the current Memorandum of Understand-ing between the City of Oakland and the Serv-ice Employees International Union, Local 1021 of 4% effective July 1,2017 and 1% effective January 1, 2019, and additional increases for select classifications listed in the Memoran-dum of Understanding of up to 3% effective January 1, 2018, 2% following Council Ratifica-tion of the Memorandum of Understanding, and/or up to 2% effective July 1,2018.
