**RECOMMENDATION** 

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Awarding A Security Services Contract To A-1 Protective Services Inc. For A Term Period Of Three (3) Years With An Option To Extend The Contract Upon Satisfactory Completion Of The Initial Term In Increments Of One (1) Year; For Up To A Total Of Two (2) Consecutive Additional Years; In An Amount Not-To-Exceed Two Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000) For Each Year Of The Contract.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The current contract for Security Services is with Cypress Private Security and expires on July 30, 2017. Approval of the resolution will authorize the City Administrator or designee to execute a contract with A-1 Protective Services Inc. in the not to exceed amount of two million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) annually for a term period of three years with an option to extend the contract after the satisfactory completion of the initial term in increments of one (1) year; for up to a total of two (2) consecutive additional years. The resolution will also authorize the City Administrator to extend the contract at the end of the term and increase spending authority per her authority on a month to month basis until a new contract is awarded, if needed.

#### **BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY**

The City utilizes the services of uniformed, unarmed contract security guards at City facilities to screen and provide directions and access for city staff and the public, oversee and monitor the removal of city property, and ensure the safety of staff and visitors. Security guards report incidents and injuries at City facilities to Facilities staff or OPD for investigation and follow-up.

This new contract will provide security services at Civic Center Complex, (City Hall, Dalziel, the Lionel J. Wilson Building) and Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, and all other City facilities requiring security services including; Oakland Main and Branch Libraries, four (4) Oakland Senior Centers, Recreation Centers identified by Oakland Parks and Recreation (OPR), Malonga

Casquelourd Center and Oakland Public Works (OPW) corporation yards at 7101 Edgewater, 5050 Coliseum and 750 50th Avenue; and at other locations requiring security in response to emergencies or other disasters.

#### **ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES**

In the Fall of 2016, the City initiated a request for proposal (RFP) process to secure the most qualified security contractor for a new security services contract to meet the current security needs of the City of Oakland. Legal ads were run in August of 2016 in the Oakland Tribune, El Mundo, Oakland Post and Sing Tao, in October a mandatory Pre-Bid Proposal Conference was held, the proposal due date was November 14, 2016. The City received responses to the RFP from six (6) security firms. The proposals were reviewed for completeness and a formal contract compliance analysis was performed on each proposal. All 6 companies were invited to move forward and participate in interviews, those interviews were held on February 6, 2017.

The oral interview process consisted of a question and answer segment and time allotted for a presentation from each company. The interview panel consisted of three subject matter experts. The three-panel members consisted of a Facilities Complex Manager with an extensive background in governmental facility security operations and contract management, a Client Representative and Manager for Oakland Parks and Recreation Department and a Client Representative for the Oakland Public Library and Manager overseeing security functions for Library services.

The results of the interviews and selection process produced A1 Protective Services, Inc. a local security contractor as the most qualified and responsive proposer. A-1 Protective Services Inc. is a highly credentialed security company with key security expertise in all areas that the City of Oakland requires, including, experience in securing high-rise and high level security. A-1 Protective Services experience includes security services for government facilities, public utility companies, parking structures municipal corporation yards, and experience in crowd control, special events.

Out of the 6 companies that participated in the interview process, the top three (3) scores were very close, those three companies in ranked order are; (1) A-1 Protective Services Inc, (2) American Guard Services Inc. and (3) ABC Security Services, Inc., **Table A** shows the final ranking scores inclusive of City of Oakland earned preference points.

The top three companies as shown on the table above are A-1 Protective Services Inc., American Guard Services and ABC Security Services Inc..

Of the top three companies A-1 Protective Services (ranked the highest) and ABC Security Services Inc (ranked third) and are both Oakland based companies. Each has many years of relevant experience in securing governmental facilities similar to the City of Oakland. American Guard Services Inc. ranked second and is headquartered in Carson CA., with a local office in San Leandro, CA., their governmental experience is limited based on the information they provided.

A-1 Protective Services has over 18 years of experience in securing government and municipal facilities. Their expertise and awareness of current security issues best matches the needs of the City. They have highly trained and qualified security personnel, and supervisory and managerial staff. During the interview A-1 Protective Services representatives demonstrated their ability to provide the desired security service for the City of Oakland, their references from all contacts were positive and reinforced the company's ability to fulfill the security needs of the City of Oakland.

The City is requesting that A-1 Protective Services Inc. consider the importance of enhancing security services as well as retaining institutional knowledge and continuity of service by encouraging the dedicated guard staff employed by the incumbent firm, assigned to City of Oakland posts to apply and be considered for employment with their company. As is industry standard for security service contracts, the current employees would be required to apply and go through A-1 Protective Services Inc's. formal hiring and screening process to ensure that they meet minimum requirements as part of the transition process.

#### COMPLIANCE WITH CITY L/SLBE and EBO PROGRAMS

The Department of Contracting and Purchasing (DCP), Division of Social Equity, conducted a compliance review of the six (6) proposals in response to the RFP for security services contract to evaluate for the minimum 50% Local and Small Local Business Enterprise (L/SLBE) participation requirement, and a preliminary review for compliance with the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO). The full Compliance Review is attached as (*Attachment A*).

As noted in the chart on the previous page, all firms exceeded the minimum 50% L/SLBE participation requirement. A-1 Protective Services, Inc., ABC Security Service, Inc., and ANI Private Security and Patrol, Inc. are not EBO compliant. The selected firm is required to come into compliance with EBO prior to contract award.

The two companies on the chart below failed to meet the minimum 50% L/SLBE participation requirement, therefore they are non-compliant with L/SLBE participation requirements.

As reflected on the charts above; four of the six companies met the minimum 50% L/SLBE requirement and were deemed responsive for the compliance evaluation. A-1 Protective Services was one of the four. Two companies were deemed unresponsive as they failed to meet the minimum 50% L/SLBE participation. Only one firm, Cypress Private Security Inc. met the City's EBO compliance requirement. The selected firm will be required to satisfy both L/SLBE and EBO compliance prior to contract award.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The City's Current Budget for security is \$2.25M per year. The new contract is \$2.5M per year, which includes the cost increases for Consumer Price Increase adjustment compliance with Oakland's Cost of Living Ordinance, other wage increases and costs for additional services as required. Funding for Security services for each requesting City Department is based on the current levels of service and contract rates. Funding is available within each requesting City Department funding sources including the Facilities Services Fund (4400) the Library Services Retention and Enhancement Fund (2240) and the Multipurpose Reserve Fund (1750).

#### PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

Staff will complete the City's required Schedule L - Consultant Evaluation Form annually. The City will exercise the two, one (1) year extension options only if a satisfactory rating is achieved for the prior year's performance.

#### **PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST**

In October 2016, the Public Works Department reached out to local firms registered in iSupplier and advertised in local newspapers whose circulation is recognized to reach local and diverse audiences (Oakland Tribune, El Mundo, Oakland Post and Sing Tao) as part of the RFP process.

#### COORDINATION

Oakland Public Works (OPW), Facilities Services Division. coordinated with the City Administrator's Office of Contracts and Compliance, the Office of the City Attorney the City's Budget Office; the Department of Human Services (DHS), the Oakland Public Library (OPL) and Oakland Parks and Recreation (OPR) for the development of this report.

#### **SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES**

**Economic**: The selected contractor has been certified as meeting the minimum 50% SLBE requirement by the Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing. The local economy will benefit from the services provided by the terms of this contract through job opportunities as well as the generating of business tax revenue.

**Environmental**: No environmental opportunities were identified to be available through this contract.

**Social Equity**: The resolution will protect the health and safety of the public and the building occupants by providing safe and secure facilities to visit, conduct official business, participate in various activities and meet local public officials and City representatives for various issues.

#### ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt resolutions awarding a security services contract to A-1 Protective Services Inc. for a term period of three (3) years with an option to extend the contract upon satisfactory completion of the initial term in increments of one (1) year; for up to a total of two (2) consecutive additional years, in an amount not-to-exceed two million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) annually.

RESOLUTION AWARDING A SECURITY SERVICES CONTRACT TO A-1 PROTECTIVE SERVICES INC. FOR A TERM PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS WITH AN OPTION TO EXTEND THE CONTRACT UPON SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF THE INITIAL TERM IN INCREMENTS OF ONE (1) YEAR; FOR UP TO A TOTAL OF TWO (2) CONSECUTIVE ADDITIONAL YEARS; IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED TWO MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,500,000) FOR EACH YEAR OF THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, The City of Oakland has various municipal facilities and properties that require unarmed security personnel to provide security services to protect the public, city personnel, officials and property; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited proposals for unarmed security services from qualified firms to provide security services for City facilities and six firms responded and submitted proposals; and

WHEREAS, A-1 Protective Services Inc., a certified L/SLBE bidding as a prime, participated in an interview and screening process and was ranked number one (1) through that process and deemed the most qualified and responsive bidder for the project; and
