

NOTICE AND DIGEST

REGARDING AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 INCREASE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, FIXING THE RATE OF PROPERTY TAX, AND LEVYING A TAX ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2018-19 FOR VOTER-APPROVED MEASURE M (THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES RETENTION ACT OF 1997), MEASURE N (THE PARAMEDIC SERVICES ACT OF 1997), MEASURE Q (THE LIBRARY SERVICES RETENTION AND ENHANCEMENT ACT), AND MEASURE Z (THE 2014 OAKLAND PUBLIC SAFETY AND SERVICES VIOLENCE PREVENTION ACT).

On Tuesday, June 5, 2018, the City Council of Oakland, California will consider an ordinance authorizing an increase to the special parcel tax imposed for emergency medical services retention, paramedic services, library services and retention, and violence prevention and public safety services in accordance with the voter-approved Measure M (The Emergency Medical Services Retention Act of 1997), Measure N (The Paramedic Services Act of 1997), Measure Q (The Library Services Retention And Enhancement Act), and Measure Z (The 2014 Oakland Public Safety And Services Violence Prevention Act). The ordinance proposes an increase, effective July 1, 2018, of 3.2 percent consistent with the Consumer Price Index for the San Francisco Bay Area, and authorizes the City to levy the tax at the new rates. The Public Hearing is set for Tuesday, June 5, 2018 at 6:30 p.m., to be held before the City Council in the Council Chambers located on the Third Floor of City Hall, One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, Oakland, California.
