

NOTICE AND DIGEST

AN ORDINANCE (1) ENABLING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CITY CHARTER AMENDMENT CREATING THE OAKLAND POLICE COMMISSION AND THE COMMUNITY POLICE REVIEW AGENCY, (2) ESTABLISHING A CIVILIAN INSPECTOR GENERAL, AND (3) REQUIRING AN ANNUAL REPORT AND PRESENTATION BY THE COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD TO THE COMMISSION.

This ordinance adds Chapter 2.45 to the Oakland Municipal Code in order to: 1) enable implementation of the City Charter Amendment creating the Oakland Police Commission by providing more detail regarding the Commission's powers and duties, including but not limited to the powers and duties of any Discipline Committee formed by the Chair of the Commission, 2) establish a civilian Inspector General and an Office of the Inspector General with attendant staff, and (3) require an annual report and presentation by the Community Policing Advisory Board to the Commission. This ordinance also adds Chapter 2.46 to the Oakland Municipal Code in order to enable implementation of the City Charter Amendment creating the Community Police Review Agency by providing more detail regarding the Agency's functions and duties.
