RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The Public Works Committee Receive An Informational Report Providing An Update On Oakland Public Works' Efforts To Address Illegal Dumping In The City, Including An Evaluation Of Oakland Public Works' Proactive Illegal Dumping Pickup Program.

REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL

Staff submitted the *Update on Illegal Dumping* Informational Report dated August 31, 2018, for the September 25 Public Works Committee meeting, which was subsequently cancelled. Since that time, staff identified several clerical errors in the original report and has provided corrections within this supplemental report to ensure accurate information is shared in advance of the October 9, 2018, Public Works Committee meeting.

Pilot Program

On page two (2) of the informational report, within the *Pilot Program* section, the table entitled '*Illegal Dumping Pilot Project - Results*' contained clerical errors in the "TOTAL" row. The corrected table is below:

The chart above identifies the total number of work orders (or proactive pickups) closed by month, tonnage by month, and total miles traveled by the crew. One major note in assessing the pilot project was the amount of tonnage picked up in District 6 for May 2018. The Rapid Response Crew (RRC) only collected 60.3 tons of illegal dumping, which was a 29.7 percent decrease from the previous month. This was a result of proactive cleaning, whereby the illegal dumping piles did not grow due to the proactive pick-ups or in some cases, illegal dumping locations became clean zones.

Compliance with Trash Reduction Requirements

Within this section of the informational report, staff would like to clarify that in **Fiscal Year (FY) 2016- 2017** the City reported 74.7 percent trash load reduction. This Fiscal Year, the City's continued trash reduction efforts resulted in 78.6 percent trash load reduction.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the Public Works Committee receive an informational report providing an update on Oakland Public Works' efforts to address illegal dumping in the City, including an evaluation of Oakland Public Works' illegal dumping pickup program.
