

RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends that the City Council:

- 1. Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator Or Designee To Execute Professional Services Agreements For On-Call Geotechnical Engineering Services With One (1) Firm For Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) With: 1) Parikh Consultants, Inc.; And
- Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator Or Designee To Execute Professional Services Agreements For On-Call Geotechnical Engineering Services With Seven (7) Firm For Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) Each With: 1) AGS Inc., 2) ARUP, 3) Cal Engineering And Geology, 4) FUGRO, 5) Langan Engineering And Environmental Services, Inc., 6) Ninyo and Moore, And 7) Terraphase Engineering Inc.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of both resolutions will authorize the City Administrator to execute On-Call Geotechnical Engineering professional services agreements in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) with Parikh Consultants, Inc. and in the amount of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) Each With: 1) AGS Inc., 2) ARUP, 3) Cal Engineering And Geology, 4) FUGRO, 5) Langan Engineering And Environmental Services, Inc., 6) Ninyo and Moore, and 7) Terraphase Engineering Inc., for a period of three (3) years. The professional services agreements are needed to provide on-call geotechnical engineering services to assist the Department of Transportation (DOT) and other City departments in emergency roadway response and design of roadway repair and restoration projects. These sources are funded by local, regional, State, and Federal sources, such as Measure B, Measure BB, Measure KK, and various other funding sources. The approval of these resolutions will not result in additional appropriation of funds. Funds will be identified prior to execution of each task order.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The Oakland Department of Transportation (OakDOT), Great Streets Delivery Division, performs planning and design, for the City to deliver capital improvement projects. The On-Call Geotechnical Engineering professional services agreements are needed to assist OakDOT and other departments and divisions with various projects. Professional services may include, but are not limited to the following: performing geotechnical analysis, site investigations, site assessments, recommending proper testing methods, arranging for all subsurface investigations, laboratory work, analyzing subsurface data, generate reports, evaluating solution alternative, preparing plans and specifications for construction, coordinating the project with regulatory agencies and securing permits, providing cost estimating, construction support, facilitating special inspections and material testing.

In June 2018, OakDOT issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to provide On-Call Geotechnical Engineering services in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code, OMC Chapter 2.04.051. A two-tier pre-qualification process was utilized to increase the level of small business participation. Each Tier I contract is for \$250,000, and each Tier II contract is for \$750,000. The duration of each contract is three (3) years.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

With the passage of Measure BB, SB1, and Measure KK, as well as an influx of additional grant funding, the City is in need of engineering services to support, design, and deliver projects. The On-Call Geotechnical Engineering Services (Non-Federal) contracts provide a means for delivering projects and improvements in a timely and cost-effective manner.

The RFQ for On-Call Geotechnical Engineering Services is a part of a much larger coordinated effort to invite firms to provide professional and technical services to the City of Oakland on two (2) federally funded engineering disciplines and six (6) non-federal funded engineering disciplines.

The two Federal disciplines are for:

- (1) Civil Engineering
- (2) Structural Engineering

The six non-Federal disciplines are for:

- (1) Civil Engineering
- (2) Geotechnical Engineering (the subject of this report)
- (3) Transportation Engineering and ITS
- (4) Plan Review, Permitting and Field Inspection
- (5) Land Surveying
- (6) Construction Management

The contract capacity and overall need for each of these disciplines was calculated based both on existing projects in early development, as well as future projects on the horizon.

On July 27, 2018, Public Works Department, Contract Services Division received three (3) Tier I proposals and eight (8) Tier II proposals. Two (2) Tier 1 proposals and one (1) Tier II proposal did not meet the City Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirements and were deemed non-responsive. All remaining eight (8) proposals met or exceeded the City's minimum 50% LBE/SLBE requirements and received preference points. All selected firms are required to be Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO) compliant prior to contract execution. The information has been verified in the Social Equity Contract Compliance Memorandums and are provided in **Attachment A** for Tier I firms and in **Attachment B** for Tier II firms. All the eight firms are based in Oakland, and have had local Oakland experiences.

The following firms submitted a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ), in alphabetical order:

A panel of three professionals with experience in the scope services and project typologies identified in the RFQ evaluated the submittals. The following evaluation criteria were used as set forth in the RFQ:

- Experience;
- Qualifications;
- Organization and Responsiveness; and
- Approach.

Based on the panel's evaluation results, contract requirements, and contract capacity needs, a recommendation was made for the most qualified firms to provide the needed on-call civil engineering services. Each of these selected firms clearly demonstrated their understanding of the scope and requirements in their submittals.

The following firms are recommended for contracts, in alphabetical order:

• Parikh Consultants, Inc. (Oakland based)

- AGS, Inc. (Oakland based)
- ARUP (Oakland based)
- Cal Engineering and Geology (Oakland based)
- FUGRO (Oakland based)
- Langan Engineering And Environmental Services, Inc. (Oakland based)
- Ninyo and Moore
- Terraphase Engineering, Inc. (Oakland based)

As projects arise, the City will request on-call consultants with the appropriate expertise to submit proposals for the project that includes a scope of work, schedule for completion, and fee. The City will evaluate the proposals on a qualification basis, select a consultant, negotiate, and assign a Task Order. The on-call contracts are not for a specific project. No minimum amount of work is implied or guaranteed, and no appropriation is made as a result of this action. Individual task orders will vary but in no case will exceed the approved contract amounts.

FISCAL IMPACT

Since this set of on-call contracts represents a proactive plan to bring on resources that are projected to be needed, specific projects, studies, and associated funding sources are not yet identified. Overall these services will be needed for delivery of projects citywide funded by local, regional, State, and Federal sources, such as Measure B, Measure BB, Measure KK, and various other funding sources. The approval of these resolutions will not result in additional appropriation of funds. Funds will be identified prior to execution of each task order.

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

In June 2018, OakDOT reached out to various local, ethnic, minority, and disadvantaged communities in Oakland, and encouraged them to participate in the RFQ process. This included contacting the Oakland African American Chamber of Commerce, National Organization of Minority Architects (SF-NOMA), Bay Area Black Professional Organizations, Hispanic Engineers Builders and Contractors of California, and the Regional Technical Training Center (RTTC). Outreach materials are provided in **Attachment C**. Additionally, staff provided notice to labor representatives, per the terms and conditions of the current Memorandums of Understanding with Local 21, Service Employees International Union (SEIU) 1021, and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) prior to the formal issuance of the RFQ.

A legal advertisement for the RFQ was posted on June 15, 2018. The RFQ was formally advertised in a total of eleven (11) newspapers in various languages to reach as many local firms as possible. This included the San Francisco Chronicle, Oakland Tribune, Oakland Post, East Bay Express, World Journal, El Mundo, La Opinion Del La Bahia, Vision Hispana, Sing

Tao, The Korea Times, and Nhat Bao Cali Today. The City's web-based procurement system iSupplier and CIPlist.com were utilized for distribution of the RFQ with documents available free of charge online.

COORDINATION

This report and legislation have been reviewed by the Office of the City Attorney and the Budget Bureau. The Contracts and Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office provided the compliance analysis of firms.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

Below is a summary of the selected firms' previous experience as consultants for the City of Oakland:

Tier I Firms

• Parikh Consultants, Inc. - This firm has not held a contract with the City previously.

Tier II Firms

- AGS, Inc. This firm currently holds a contract with the City to perform geotechnical services and is performing in a satisfactory manner.
- ARUP This firm currently holds a contract with the City to perform structural engineering services.
- Cal Engineering and Geology This firm currently holds a contract with the City to perform geotechnical services and is performing in a satisfactory manner.
- FUGRO This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform geotechnical services.
- Langan Engineering and Environmental Services, Inc. This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform geotechnical services.
- Ninyo and Moore This firm currently holds a contract with the City to perform geotechnical services and is performing in a satisfactory manner.
- Terraphase Engineering, Inc.– This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform engineering services.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The contracts will generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City by those firms who work on the projects. Local, Oakland-based businesses will be utilized in the construction of many of these projects and will benefit directly.

Environmental: Projects completed under these contracts will also implement the Best Management Practices for the protection of storm water runoff during construction to prevent pollutants from entering the storm drain systems.

Social Equity: Projects completed under these contracts will provide greater mobility, accessibility and safety to all modes of transportation including non-motorized modes, and will support persons with disabilities and children, to access jobs, recreational facilities and other services. In addition, projects are selected and prioritized with an equity lens within the relative framework of their respective programs.

Consultants will be required to design City improvements in compliance with the physical access requirements of applicable accessibility codes and the Americans with Disabilities Act.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR ON-CALL GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000) WITH PARIKH CONSULTANTS, INC.

WHEREAS, professional on-call geotechnical engineering services are needed to provide geotechnical engineering services on various projects. The services are needed to design and review roadway damage and slope stability restoration projects; and

WHEREAS, on-call geotechnical engineering services allow Oakland Department of Transportation (OakDOT) to respond and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner; and

WHEREAS, on-call geotechnical engineering services allow OakDOT to promote greater efficiency and safety within the transportation network; and

WHEREAS, OakDOT anticipates that the possibly of severe winter storms may cause landslides and collapse roadways, will utilize the on-call geotechnical engineering services contracts; and

WHEREAS, mid-year projects will arise throughout the three-year period will likely require oncall geotechnical engineering services; and

WHEREAS, on-call geotechnical engineering services will be funded through the various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the on-call services; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code, OMC Chapter 2.04.051; and

WHEREAS, through the City's Request for Qualifications process, one Tier I firm met the requirements of OMC Chapter 2.04.045(a) for pre-qualification for on-call geotechnical engineering services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the contracts authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the contracts shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorize the City Administrator to execute a Professional Services Agreement Contract with On-Call Geotechnical Engineering Services to one Tier I firm: Parikh Inc.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the total amount of the Contract for one Tier I firm shall be for a not-to-exceed amount of \$250,000; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the terms of each Contract shall be for three (3) years; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said Contracts with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Contracts shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk.
