RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator Or Designee To Execute Professional Services Agreements For On-Call Hydrology And Stormwater Engineering Services With Nine (9) Firms For An Amount Not to Exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) Each With: 1) Arup, 2) ENGEO, 3) EOA, Inc., 4) Environmental Science Associates, 5) Geosyntec, 6) Northgate Environmental Management, Inc., 7) Restoration Design Group, Inc., 8) Wood **Environmental And Infrastructure Solutions, And 9) Wood Rodgers.**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of this resolution will authorize the City Administrator or designee to execute on-call hydrology and stormwater engineering professional services agreements in the amount of Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) each with: 1) Arup, 2) ENGEO, 3) EOA, Inc., 4) Environmental Science Associates, 5) Geosyntec, 6) Northgate Environmental Management, Inc., 7) Restoration Design Group, Inc., 8) Wood Environmental And Infrastructure Solutions, and 9) Wood Rodgers for a period of five (5) years. The professional services agreements are needed to provide On-Call Hydrology and Stormwater Engineering services to assist Oakland Public Works and other City departments with technical and engineering services to support the delivery of projects related to stormwater management and Oakland's waterways. Funds will be identified prior to execution of each task order.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

Oakland Public Works (OPW), Watershed and Stormwater Management Division (WSD) performs planning and design for capital improvement projects as well as manages technical programs to ensure compliance with environmental and regulatory goals related to Oakland's stormwater discharge and waterways. The On-Call Hydrology and Stormwater Engineering professional services are needed to assist OPW, WSD and other divisions and departments with various services, including technical studies, feasibility analyses, and design and construction support services for City projects. Projects to be supported by these on-call services are related to creeks, lakes, storm drains, wetlands, riparian areas, and the waterfront.

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In October 2018, OPW issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to provide On-Call Hydrology and Stormwater Engineering services in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code (OMC), Chapter 2.04.051.

The RFQ utilized a two-tier process to increase small business participation. Firms submitting proposals had the option to submit at Tier I for two hundred fifty thousand dollar (\$250,000) contracts, or Tier II for seven hundred fifty thousand dollar (\$750,000) contracts. The Tier I option allowed smaller firms to directly compete with each other. The proposals submitted at both Tiers were subject to the same compliance analysis and evaluation criteria. The City Administrator has the authority to enter into Professional Services agreements of up to two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in accordance with OMC Chapter 2.04.020. As such, three (3) Tier I firms have been separately recommended for approval by the City Administrator for two hundred fifty thousand dollar (\$250,000) professional services contracts.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

The City is in need of technical and engineering services to provide technical assistance and support the design and delivery of projects. The On-Call Hydrology and Stormwater Engineering Services contracts will provide the means for delivering technical support and projects in a timely and cost effective manner. Approval of these contracts will reduce the staff time needed for selecting consultants for projects, thereby providing cost-savings to the City. The on-call contracts will improve Department efficiency by enabling staff to quickly respond to urgent and unforeseen demands such as stormwater or infrastructure emergencies during storm events, or developing design documents for grant proposals that require a rapid response that cannot be accommodated in a timely manner by issuing an individual RFP. The on-call contracts also help staff respond to numerous regulatory requirements that necessitate quick analysis to meet newly developed approaches and strategies.

The contract capacity was calculated based on an analysis of the demands for and usage of previous on-call contracts and existing projects in early development.

On November 9, 2018, City Contract Services received Statements of Qualification (SOQ) from thirteen (13) Tier II firms. Two (2) Tier II firms did not meet the City's Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirements and were deemed non-responsive:

- AGS, Inc. did not meet the 50 percent LBE/SLBE requirement
- Placeworks did not meet the 50 percent LBE/SLBE requirement

The remaining eleven (11) Tier II firms met or exceeded the City's 50 percent LBE/SLBE participation requirement and were considered for further evaluation. All selected firms are required to be compliant with the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO) of the OMC, Chapter 2.32, prior to contract execution. The information has been verified by the Social Equity Contract Compliance Memorandums and are provided in *Attachment A*.

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The following eleven (11) Tier II firms were considered for further evaluation. The list is written in alphabetical order:

- ARUP North America
- BKF Engineers
- ENGEO
- Environmental and Public Health Engineering, Inc.
- Environmental Science Associates
- Geosyntec Consultants
- Northgate Environmental Management, Inc.
- Restoration Design Group, Inc.
- Terraphase Engineering, Inc.
- Wood Environmental & Infrastructure Solutions
- Wood Rodgers

A panel of four (4) professionals with experience in the scope of services and project types identified in the RFQ evaluated the submittals. The following evaluation criteria were used:

- Experience
- Qualifications
- Organization and Responsiveness
- Approach

Based on the panel's evaluation results, contract requirements, and an assessment of Division needs, a recommendation was made for the most qualified firms to provide the needed on-call hydrology and stormwater engineering services. Each of these selected firms clearly demonstrated an understanding of the scope and requirements in their submittals.

The following nine (9) Tier II firms are recommended to the City Council for seven hundred fifty thousand dollar (\$750,000) contracts, in alphabetical order:

- ARUP North America
- ENGEO
- Environmental and Public Health Engineering
- Environmental Science Associates
- Geosyntec Consultants
- Northgate Environmental Management Inc.
- Restoration Design Group
- Wood Environmental & Infrastructure Solutions
- Wood Rodgers

Separately, as mentioned above, three (3) Tier I firms are recommended to the City Administrator for two hundred fifty thousand dollar (\$250,000) contracts, in alphabetical order:

- Aligout Associates, Inc.
- Community Design + Architecture, Inc.

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Horizon Water and Environment

The on-call contracts are not for a specific project. As projects arise, the City will request on-call consultants with the appropriate expertise to submit proposals for the project that includes a scope of work, schedule for completion, and fee. The City will evaluate the proposals on their qualifications and experience with the type of project to be completed, select a consultant, negotiate, and assign a Task Order. No minimum amount of work is implied or guaranteed, and no appropriation is made as a result of this action. Individual task orders will vary but will in no case exceed the approved contract amounts.

FISCAL IMPACT

The nine (9) Tier II agreements for an amount not to exceed seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) sum to a total of six million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$6,750,000). The on-call design and technical services for hydrology and stormwater engineering will be used for projects funded by:

- Measure DD (Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks)
- Sewer Service Fund
- Various state propositions or bond measures that provide competitive grant funding for water related projects

Approval of these contracts will not result in additional appropriation of funds. The services will be funded through previously budgeted projects and their designated funding sources. Funds will be identified prior to the performance of the design or technical services.

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

On October 1, 2018, OPW held a professional services outreach meeting in order to expand and diversify the professional services consultants working with the City. OPW reached out to various local, ethnic, minority, and disadvantaged communities in Oakland, including the Vietnamese Chamber of Commerce, the Oakland African American Chamber of Commerce, the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Alameda County, and the East Bay National Organization of Minority Architects. The meeting included presentations from Contract Compliance staff, OPW Contract Services staff, and WSD staff describing the types of services desired through the oncall contracts and well as the City's contracting procedures and requirements. Contract Services distributed outreach materials to contacts from a database of community based organizations and businesses and encouraged them to participate in the RFQ process. The database includes contacts for various local, ethnic, minority, and disadvantaged communities in Oakland. Outreach materials are provided in *Attachment B*. For Tier I, three (3) of five (5) firm's proposals had partial Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) designation. For Tier II, two (2) of thirteen (13) firm's proposals had MBE designation.

The RFQ was formally advertised in a total of five (5) newspapers in various languages including the East Bay Times, Oakland Post, El Mundo, World Journal, and The Korea Times.

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The City's web-based procurement system iSupplier and CIPlist.com were utilized for distribution of the RFQ with documents available free of charge online.

Staff provided notice to labor representatives, per the terms and conditions of the current Memorandums of Understanding with Local 21, Service Employees International (SEIU) 1021, and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) prior to the formal issuance of the RFQ. A legal advertisement for the RFQ was posted on October 19, 2018. Additionally, on October 25, 2018, WSD, Contract Services, and Contract Compliance staff held a pre-proposal meeting to further promote participation and answer questions related to the RFQ.

COORDINATION

This report and legislation have been reviewed by the Office of the City Attorney and the Budget Bureau. The Contracts and Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office provided the compliance analysis of firms.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

All nine (9) Tier II firms selected through the process are certified local firms. Eight (8) of these firms have worked with the City through past or existing on-call contracts or were selected through an RFP process for different City projects. Arup is a local firm that has not worked on City projects in the past, but has significant expertise on similar public projects.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The contracts will generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City by those firms who work on the projects. Local, Oakland-based businesses will be utilized in the construction of many of the projects developed through use of these contracts.

Environmental: The services provided by these contracts will protect and improve our stormwater quality, creeks, lakes, wetlands, shorelines, and will provide other benefits including wildlife habitat enhancement, flood protection, air quality improvement, and mitigation of other climate change impacts.

Social Equity: The proposed design services to the various projects will enhance the usage and quality of waterways in all parts of Oakland. A holistic approach that addresses watershed health and quality in the planning of these projects will improve the social connections between the upstream and downstream neighborhoods. Consultants will be required to design City improvements in compliance with the physical access requirements of applicable accessibility codes and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

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ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Administrator or designee to execute professional services agreements for on-call hydrology and stormwater engineering services with nine (9) firms for an amount not to exceed seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) each with: 1) Arup, 2) ENGEO, 3) EOA, Inc., 4) Environmental Science Associates, 5) Geosyntec, 6) Northgate Environmental Management, Inc., 7) Restoration Design Group, Inc., 8) Wood Environmental And Infrastructure Solutions, And 9) Wood Rodgers.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS FOR ON-CALL HYDROLOGY AND STORMWATER ENGINEERING SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVEN HUNDERD FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000) EACH WITH 1) ARUP, 2) ENGEO, 3) EOA, INC., 4) ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE ASSOCIATES, INC., 5) GEOSYNTEC, 6) NORTHGATE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, 7) RESTORATION DESIGN GROUP, INC., 8) WOOD ENVIRONMENTAL AND INFRASTRUCTURE SOLUTIONS, AND 9)

WHEREAS, on-call hydrology and stormwater engineering services are needed to assist Oakland Public Works and other City departments with technical, design, and engineering services to support the delivery of projects; and

WHEREAS, the City's current staffing capacity is insufficient to deliver much needed technical, design, and engineering services; and

WHEREAS, on-call professional services provide various technical, design, and engineering services to the delivery of projects related to stormwater management and Oakland's waterways; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2018, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Hydrology and Stormwater Engineering Services and thirteen (13) firms submitted Statement of Qualifications (SOQ); and

WHEREAS, eleven (11) firms met or exceeded the City Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirements and were considered for further evaluation; and

WHEREAS, two (2) firms did not meet the City (LBE/SLBE) requirement and were deemed non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, the eleven (11) firms were evaluated by a panel of four (4) professionals with experience in the scope of services and project types identified in the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, based on panel's evaluation, contract requirements, and assessment of Division needs, nine (9) firms have been selected for recommendation to be awarded with professional services agreements to provide on-call hydrology and stormwater engineering services; and

WHEREAS, on-call hydrology and stormwater engineering services will be funded through various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the on-call services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the agreements authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific, or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the agreements shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator Or Designee To Execute Professional Services Agreements For On-Call Hydrology and Stormwater Engineering Services In An Amount Not to Exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$750,000) Dollars each with: 1) Arup, 2) ENGEO, 3) EOA, Inc., 4) Environmental Science Associates, 5) Geosyntec, 6) Northgate Environmental Management, 7) Restoration Design Group, 8) Wood Environmental And Infrastructure Solutions, and 9) Wood Rodgers; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the terms of each agreement shall be executed for a five (5) year duration; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreements, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk.
