EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of the Resolutions will authorize the City Administrator or Designee To Execute Professional Services Agreements For On-Call Transportation Engineering And Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Services In The Amount Of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) Each To Two (2) Tier I Firms Including: 1) Aliquot Associates And 2) Diablo Engineering Group, and In The Amount Of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) Each To Nine (9) Tier II Firms Including: 1) Advanced Mobility Group, 2) Alta Planning+Design, 3) ARUP, 4) DKS Associates, 5) Fehr & Peers, 6) Kimley-Horn & Associates, 7) Kittelson & Associates, 8) Parsons, And 9) Wood Rodgers.

The professional services agreements are needed to provide on-call transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services to assist the Department of Transportation (DOT) and other City departments in delivering transportation projects.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The Oakland Department of Transportation (OakDOT), Great Streets Delivery Division, performs planning and design, for the City to deliver capital improvement projects. The On-Call Transportation Engineering and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) professional services agreements are needed to assist OakDOT and other Departments and Divisions with various projects. Professional services may include, but are not limited to the following: planning, engineering, design, operations, systems integration, construction support, data collection, research, staff training, and technical support. Projects and facilities include traffic signals, intelligent transportation systems, telecommunication systems, signal systems; signal operations, timing and coordination; pedestrian and bicycle facilities; transit; urban design; impact analysis, modeling; data collection and analysis; traffic calming; complete streets design, complete streets paving, intersection improvements; land surveying, parking, construction support; transportation planning; grant application; community outreach; communication, and software programs.

In June 2018, OakDOT issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to provide On-Call Transportation Engineering and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) services in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code, OMC Chapter 2.04.040 and 2.04.051. A two-tier pre-qualification process was utilized to encourage the level of small business participation. Each Tier I contract is for \$500,000, and each Tier II contract is for \$1,000,000. The duration of each contract is three (3) years.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

With the passage of Measures BB, SB 1 and Measure KK, as well as an influx of other additional grant funding, the City is in need of engineering services to support, design, and implement projects. The On-Call Transportation Engineering and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Services contracts provide the means for delivering projects and improvements in a timely and cost-effective manner.

The pros and cons of adopting legislation on two Resolutions.

1. Adopt a Resolution for Tier I firms:

Adopting a Resolution for an on-call professional services agreement for each of the two Tier I firms will meet the following objectives:

- (a) Assist OakDOT and other City Departments with planning, engineering, design, operations, systems integration, construction support, data collection, research, staff training, and technical support for various transportation projects;
- (b) Allow OakDOT to respond and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner;

(c) Allow OakDOT to promote greater efficiency and safety within the transportation network:

- (d) Allow OakDOT to implement several currently funded transportation projects, including the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 8, and MacArthur Smart City Corridor Project; and
- (e) Allow OakDOT to implement mid-year projects throughout the three-year period.

Not Adopt a Resolution for Tier I firms:

Not adopting a Resolution for an on-call professional services agreement for each of the two Tier I firms means that should the City decide to hire a consultant, City staff will need to issue a formal Request for Proposals (RFP) for each project. The RFP process is labor intensive and takes six months. This will result in a six-month delay to one or more phases of the project. For grant opportunities, the application response timelines are quite short, so the RFP process will effectively preclude the City from pursuing any future grant funds.

2. Adopt a Resolution for Tier II firms:

Adopting a Resolution for an on-call professional services agreement for each of the nine Tier II firms will meet the same objectives as listed above under "Adopt a Resolution for Tier I firms".

Not Adopt a Resolution for Tier II firms:

Not adopting a Resolution for an on-call professional services agreement for each of the nine Tier II firms means that should the City decide to hire a consultant, City staff will be faced with the same issues as described above under "Not Adopt a Resolution for Tier I firms".

The RFQ for On-Call Transportation Engineering and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Services is a part of a much larger coordinated effort to invite firms to provide professional and technical services to the City of Oakland on two (2) federally funded engineering disciplines and six (6) non-federal funded engineering disciplines.

The two Federal disciplines are:

- (1) Civil Engineering
- (2) Structural Engineering

The six non-Federal disciplines are:

- (1) Civil Engineering
- (2) Geotechnical Engineering
- (3) Transportation Engineering and Intelligent Transportation Systems (the subject of this report)
- (4) Plan Review, Permitting and Field Inspection
- (5) Land Surveying
- (6) Construction Management.

The contract capacity and overall need for each of these disciplines was calculated based both on existing projects in early development, as well as future projects on the horizon.

On July 27, 2018, City Contract Services received two (2) Tier I proposals and eleven (11) Tier II proposals. The Contract Compliance Division determined that three (2) Tier II proposals did not meet the City Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirements and were deemed non-responsive. One of the non-compliant proposal was Parsons. Parsons was non-compliant because its LBE/SLBE certification expired. Parsons subsequently applied for renewal and received a new Certification in February 2019. Consequently, only two Tier II proposals are non-LBE/SLBE compliant.

- Parsons exceeds the minimum 50% LBE/SLBE requirements.
- Rajappan & Meyers did not meet the 50% LBE/SLBE requirement.
- TJKM did not meet the 50% LBE/SLBE requirement.

All remaining eleven (11) submittals met or exceeded the City's minimum 50% LBE/SLBE requirements and received preference points. Seven firms earned preference points for meeting City criteria on Years in Oakland and/or Oakland Workforce. Seven firms are in compliance with the Equal Benefit Ordinance (EBO). All selected firms are required to be EBO compliant prior to contract execution. The information has been verified in the Social Equity Contract Compliance Memorandums and are provided in **Attachment A** for Tier I firms and in **Attachment B** for Tier II firms. Of the eleven firms, ten firms are based in Oakland, and eight firms have had local Oakland experiences.

A panel of three professionals, including one from an outside agency and two from OakDOT, evaluated the submittals. The following evaluation criteria were used as set forth in the RFQ:

- Experience;
- Qualifications:
- Organization and Responsiveness; and
- Approach.

Based on the panel's evaluation results, contract requirements, and contract capacity needs, staff selected and recommended all eleven firms to provide the on-call transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services. Each of these selected firms clearly demonstrated their understanding of the scope and requirements in their submittals.

The following firms are recommended for contracts, in alphabetical order:

Tier I Firms

- 1. Aliquot Associates (Oakland based)
- 2. Diablo Engineering Group (Oakland based)

Tier II Firms

- 1. Advanced Mobility Group (Walnut Creek based)
- 2. Alta Planning+Design (Oakland based)

- 4. DKS Associates (Oakland based)
- 5. Fehr & Peers (Oakland based)
- 6. Kimley-Horn & Associates (Oakland based)

As projects arise, the City will request on-call consultants with the appropriate expertise to submit proposals for the project that includes a scope of work, schedule for completion, and fee. The City will evaluate the proposals on a qualification basis, select a consultant, negotiate, and assign a Task Order. The on-call contracts are not for a specific project. No minimum amount of work is implied or guaranteed, and no appropriation is made as a result of this action. Individual task orders will vary but in no case will exceed the approved contract amounts.

FISCAL IMPACT

Since this set of on-call contracts represents a proactive plan to bring on resources that are projected to be needed, specific projects, studies, and associated funding sources are not yet identified. Overall these services will be needed for delivery of projects citywide funded by regional, State and local sources, such as Measure BB, Measure KK, and various other funding sources. The approval of these resolutions will not result in additional appropriation of funds. Funds will be identified prior to execution of each task order.

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

In June 2018, OakDOT reached out to various local, ethnic, minority, and disadvantaged communities in Oakland, and encouraged them to participate in the RFQ process. This included contacting the Oakland African American Chamber of Commerce, National Organization of Minority Architects (SF-NOMA), Bay Area Black Professional Organizations, Hispanic Engineers Builders and Contractors of California, and the Regional Technical Training Center (RTTC). Outreach materials are provided in **Attachment C**. Additionally, staff provided a Notice to labor representatives, per the terms and conditions of the current Memorandums of Understanding with Local 21, Service Employees International Union (SEIU) 1021, and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) prior to the formal issuance of the RFQ.

A legal advertisement for the RFQ was posted on June 15, 2018. The RFQ was formally advertised in a total of eleven (11) newspapers in various languages to reach as many local firms as possible. This included the San Francisco Chronicle, East Bay Times, Oakland Post, East Bay Express, World Journal, El Mundo, La Opinion Del La Bahia, Vision Hispana, Sing Tao, The Korea Times, and Nhat Bao Cali Today. The City's web-based procurement system iSupplier and CIPlist.com were utilized for distribution of the RFQ with documents online available free of charge.

COORDINATION

This report and legislation have been reviewed by the Office of the City Attorney and the Budget Bureau. The Contracts and Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office provided the compliance analysis of firms.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

All eleven (11) firms selected through the process are certified local firms. Nine (9) of these firms have worked with the City a prime consultant or as subconsultant through past or existing on-call contracts or were selected through RFP process for various City projects.

Below is a summary of the selected firms' previous experience as consultants for the City of Oakland:

- 1. Aliquot Associates Has completed one on-call task order with the City in the last two years.
- 2. Diablo Engineering Group Has no prior on-call contract with the City. Has performed as on-call subconsultant on various past and on-going City projects.

Tier II Firms

1. Advanced Mobility Group - Has no prior on-call contract with the City. Has performed as on-call prime consultant under Stantec until the group formed a new company named Advanced Mobility Group.

- 2. Alta Planning+Design Has completed one on-call task order with the City in the last two years.
- 3. ARUP Has not completed any on-call task orders with the City in the last two years.
- 4. DKS Associates Has completed two on-call task orders in the last two years and was rated excellent.
- 5. Fehr & Peers Has not completed any on-call task orders with the City in the last two years. Has performed as prime consultant and subconsultant on various past and ongoing City projects.
- 6. Kimley-Horn & Associates Has completed two on-call task orders in the last two years and was rated satisfactory.
- 7. Kittelson & Associates Has completed one on-call task order with the City in the last two years. Has performed as prime consultant and subconsultant on various past and ongoing City projects.
- 8. Parsons Has no prior on-call contract with the City.
- 9. Wood Rodgers Has completed two on-call task orders in the last two years and was rated average.

Consultant performance evaluations are provided in *Attachment D*.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The contracts will generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City by those firms who work on the projects. Local, Oakland-based businesses will be utilized in the construction of many of these projects and will benefit directly.

Environmental: Projects completed under these contracts will also implement the Best Management Practices for the protection of storm water runoff during construction to prevent pollutants from entering the storm drain systems.

Social Equity: Projects completed under these contracts will provide improved safety, accessibility and mobility to all modes of transportation including non-motorized modes, and will support persons with disabilities and children, to access jobs, recreational facilities and other services. In addition, projects are selected and prioritized with an equity lens within the relative framework of their respective programs.

Consultants will be required to design City improvements in compliance with the physical access requirements of applicable accessibility codes and the Americans with Disabilities Act.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS FOR ON-CALL TRANSPORTATION ENGINEERING AND INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS (ITS) SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) EACH TO TWO (2) TIER I FIRMS INCLUDING: 1) ALIQUOT ASSOCIATES AND 2) DIABLO ENGINEERING GROUP

WHEREAS, professional on-call transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services are needed to assist OakDOT and other City Departments with planning, engineering, design, operations, systems integration, construction support, data collection, research, staff training, and technical support for various transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, on-call transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services allow OakDOT to respond and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner; and

WHEREAS, on-call transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services allow OakDOT to promote greater efficiency and safety within the transportation network; and

WHEREAS, OakDOT anticipates that several currently funded transportation projects, including the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 8, and MacArthur Smart City Corridor Project, will utilize the on-call transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services contracts; and

WHEREAS, mid-year projects will arise throughout the three-year period will likely require oncall transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services; and

WHEREAS, on-call transportation engineering and intelligent transportation systems (ITS) services will be funded through the various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the on-call services; and

WHEREAS, the City issued an Request for Qualification in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04.040 and 2.04.051; and

WHEREAS, the two (2) Tier I firms have met the City's 50% Local/Small Local Business Enterprises (LBE/SLBE) Program requirements and have been determined to be in compliance with the Equal Benefits Ordinance (EBO); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the contracts authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the contracts shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorize the City Administrator to execute a Professional Services Agreement with On-Call Transportation Engineering and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) Services to each of two (2) Tier I firms including: 1) Aliquot Associates and 2) Diablo Engineering Group.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the total amount of the Contract for each of two (2) Tier I firms shall be for a not-to-exceed amount of \$500,000; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the terms of each Contract shall be for three (3) years and is anticipated to cover the time period from May 2019 to May 2022; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said Contracts with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Contracts shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk
