RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator, Or Designee, To Enter Into A Total Of Seven (7) Professional Services Agreement Contracts For On-Call Construction Management (CM) Services, In The Amount Of Seven Hundred And Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) Each With: 1) Acumen Building Enterprise, Inc., 2) AGS, Inc., 3) Biggs Cardosa Associates Inc., 4) Consolidated CM, 5) Ghirardelli & Associates 6) Kal Krishnan Consulting Services, Inc., And 7) VSCE, Inc.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The professional services agreement contracts are needed to provide Construction Management (CM) support functions and advance the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP). The services that are needed for construction management support include, but are not limited to, preconstruction activities, construction contract management, resident engineering, field inspections, materials testing, contract closeout, claims negotiation, schedule analysis, change order analysis, etc. Capital improvement projects for which CM services are required can include but are not limited to the following types of projects:

- Pavement Reconstruction and Rehabilitation
- Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements
- Retaining wall and slide repairs
- Streetlight Pole Replacement
- Traffic Signal Installation
- Sewer Main Replacement and Rehabilitation
- Sewer Force Main Replacement and Rehabilitation
- Sewer Pump Station Rehabilitation and Replacement
- Storm Drain Replacement and Rehabilitation
- Streetscape Improvements
- Landscape Architectural improvements
- Architectural building construction/renovation
- Bridge construction

- Creek restoration and improvement
- Park and Sport Field Construction/rehabilitation

The contracts are for a three-year period.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The Oakland Public Works (OPW), Project Delivery Division, performs construction management and project management functions for capital improvement projects for the City of Oakland. The volume of projects has increased in the past budget cycles from approximately \$54M in Capital Projects budgeted in Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-15 to \$72M in FY 2015-16 to \$120M in FY 2017-18. Measure KK, one of the prominent funding sources within the CIP, has a requirement to expend funds within a certain timeframe. As staffing levels increase to keep pace with the anticipated volume of projects to be delivered, CM resources, when needed, will be supplemented through this on-call contract. The On-Call CM professional services agreements are needed to assist OPW's Project Delivery Division on various construction projects. Professional services include, but are not limited to, preconstruction activities, construction contract management, resident engineering, field inspections, materials testing, contract closeout, claims negotiation, schedule analysis, and change order analysis.

In June 2018, OPW issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to provide On-Call CM Services in accordance with Oakland Municipal Code, (OMC) Chapter 2.04.051. A pre-qualification process was utilized to include local and small business participation. Each contract will be for \$750,000 and for a duration of three (3) years.

The RFQ for on-call CM is a part of a much larger coordinated effort to invite firms to provide professional and technical services to the City of Oakland on two (2) federally funded engineering disciplines and six (6) non-federal funded engineering disciplines.

The two Federal disciplines are for:

- (1) Civil Engineering
- (2) Structural Engineering

The six non-Federal disciplines are for:

- (1) Civil Engineering
- (2) Geotechnical Engineering
- (3) Transportation Engineering and ITS
- (4) Plan Review, Permitting and Field Inspection
- (5) Land Surveying
- (6) Construction Management.

These on-call contracts will provide administrative cost savings to the City, compared to a project-by-project consultant selection process. Individual task orders under the contracts will

Item: _____ Public Works Committee April 9, 2019 vary from small amounts, for studies and support services, up to the full amount of the agreements, in the case of large projects requiring full design and support services.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

With the passage of Measure B, Measure BB, and Measure KK, as well as an influx of additional grant funding, the City is in a position requiring significant engineering services to support, design, and deliver projects. The on-call CM services contracts provide a means for supplementing the delivery of projects and improvements in a timely and cost-effective manner.

The professional services agreement for on-call CM contracts for each of the seven (7) firms is seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000.00). The duration of each contract is three (3) years, with options to extend should capacity remain. These firms will support the City given the anticipated increase in the number of bond-funded and grant-funded projects in the coming years.

The contract capacity and overall need for each CM service was calculated based on both existing projects in early development, as well as future projects on the horizon. An analysis of projects with budgeted or awarded funding as well as existing capacity for delivery were factors used in the contract capacity determination.

On July 27, 2018, City Contract Services received ten (10) submittals in response to the RFQ. A list of all firms that submitted Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) are below. Two submittals did not meet the City's Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirements, and were deemed non-responsive. The remaining eight (8) submittals met or exceeded the City's minimum 50 percent LBE/SLBE requirements and received preference points. Six firms earned preference points for meeting the City's criteria on Years in Oakland and/or Oakland Workforce. Five firms are in compliance with the Equal Benefit Ordinance (EBO). All selected firms are required to be EBO compliant prior to contract execution. The information has been verified by the Social Equity Contract Compliance Memorandums and is provided in *Attachment A*.

The following firms submitted a SOQ, in alphabetical order:

- Acumen Building Enterprise, Inc.
- AGS, Inc.
- Biggs Cardosa Associates Inc
- Consolidated CM
- Cooper Construction and Engineering
- Ghirardelli & Associates
- Kal Krishnan Consulting Services, Inc
- O'Connor Construction Management, Inc.
- Parsons
- VSCE, Inc.

A panel of three professionals with experience in the scope services and project types identified in the RFQ evaluated the submittals. The following evaluation criteria were used as set forth in the RFQ:

- Experience
- Qualifications
- Organization and Responsiveness
- Approach

Based on the panel's evaluation results, contract requirements, and contract capacity needs, a recommendation was made for the most qualified firms to provide the needed on-call construction management services. Each of these selected firms clearly demonstrated their understanding of the scope and requirements in their submittals.

The following firms are recommended for contracts, in alphabetical order:

- Acumen Building Enterprise, Inc.
- AGS, Inc.
- Biggs Cardosa Associates Inc.
- Consolidated CM
- Ghirardelli & Associates
- Kal Krishnan Consulting Services, Inc.
- VSCE, Inc.

As projects arise, the City will request on-call consultants with the appropriate expertise to submit proposals for the project that includes a scope of work, schedule for completion, and fee. This request will occur only if the Construction Management team doesn't have staff resource capacity to manage the project, or due to other factors. The City will evaluate the proposals on a qualification basis, select a consultant, negotiate, and assign a Task Order. The on-call contracts are not for a specific project. No minimum amount of work is implied or guaranteed, and no appropriation is made as a result of this action. Individual task orders will vary but in no case will exceed the approved contract amounts.

FISCAL IMPACT

Since this set of on-call contracts represents a proactive plan to bring on resources that are projected to be needed, specific projects, and associated funding sources are not yet identified. Overall these services will be needed for delivery of projects citywide funded by local, regional, and State sources, such as Measure B, Measure BB, Measure KK, Active Transportation Program (ATP), Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), Safe Routes to School (SR2), Proposition 68, and other grant sources. The approval of these resolutions will not result in additional appropriation of funds. Funds will be identified within individual projects prior to execution of each task order.

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

In June 2018, OPW reached out to various local, ethnic, minority, and disadvantaged communities in Oakland, and encouraged them to participate in the RFQ process. This included contacting the Oakland African American Chamber of Commerce, National Organization of Minority Architects (SF-NOMA), Bay Area Black Professional Organizations, Hispanic Engineers Builders and Contractors of California, and the Regional Technical Training Center (RTTC). Outreach materials are provided in *Attachment B*. Additionally, staff provided notice to labor representatives, per the terms and conditions of the current Memorandums of Understanding with Local 21, Service Employees International Union (SEIU) 1021, and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) prior to the formal issuance of the RFQ.

A legal advertisement for the RFQ was posted on June 15, 2018. The RFQ was formally advertised in a total of eleven (11) newspapers in various languages to reach as many local firms as possible. This included the San Francisco Chronicle, Oakland Tribune, Oakland Post, East Bay Express, World Journal, El Mundo, La Opinion Del La Bahia, Vision Hispana, Sing Tao, The Korea Times, and Nhat Bao Cali Today. The legal advertisement is provided in *Attachment C*. The City's web-based procurement system iSupplier and CIPlist.com were utilized for distribution of the RFQ with documents available free of charge online.

COORDINATION

This report and legislation have been reviewed by the Office of the City Attorney and the Controller's Bureau. The Contracts and Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office provided the compliance analysis of firms.

PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

Two firms recommended for contracts have previous experience as a consultant for the City of Oakland in a capacity to perform professional services. Below is a summary of each firm:

- Acumen Building Enterprise, Inc. This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform professional services.
- AGS, Inc. This firm currently holds a contract with the City to perform professional services and is performing in a satisfactory manner.
- Biggs Cardosa Associates Inc. This firm currently holds a contract with the City to perform professional services and is performing in a satisfactory manner.
- Consolidated CM This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform professional services.
- Ghirardelli & Associates This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform professional services.
- Kal Krishnan Consulting Services, Inc. This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform professional services.
- VSCE, Inc. This firm has not held a contract with the City to perform professional services.

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SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The contracts will generate business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City by those firms who work on the projects. Local, Oakland-based businesses will be utilized in the construction management of many of these projects and will benefit directly.

Environmental: Projects completed under these contracts will help improve the City's infrastructure which could help to improve the environment.

Social Equity: Projects completed under these contracts will provide residents, including persons with disabilities and children, with access to jobs, recreational facilities and other services. In addition, projects are selected and prioritized with an equity lens within the relative framework of their respective programs.

Consultants will be required to manage construction of City improvements in compliance with the physical access requirements of applicable accessibility codes and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Administrator, or designee, to enter into a total of seven (7) professional services agreement contracts for on-call construction management (CM) services, in the amount of seven hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) each with: 1) Acumen Building Enterprise, Inc., 2) AGS, Inc., 3) Biggs Cardosa Associates Inc., 4) Consolidated CM, 5) Ghirardelli & Associates 6) Kal Krishnan Consulting Services, Inc., and 7) VSCE, Inc.





RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO A TOTAL OF SEVEN (7) PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT CONTRACTS FOR ON-CALL CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT (CM) SERVICES, IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$750,000) EACH WITH 1) ACUMEN BUILDING ENTERPRISE, INC., 2) AGS, INC., 3) BIGGS CARDOSA ASSOCIATES, INC., 4) CONSOLIDATED CM, 5) GHIRADELLI & ASSOCIATES, 6) KAL KRISHNAN CONSULTING SERVICES, INC., AND 7) VSCE, INC.

WHEREAS, professional construction management services are needed to assist OPW and other City Departments but are not limited to, preconstruction activities, construction contract management, resident engineering, field inspections, materials testing, contract closeout, claims negotiation, schedule analysis, change order analysis, etc.; and

WHEREAS, on-call construction management services allow OPW and other City Departments to respond and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner when staff resources are not available; and

WHEREAS, on-call construction management services allow OPW and other City Departments to promote greater efficiency and safety within the Capital Improvement network; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2018, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Construction Management Services and ten (10) firms submitted Statement of Qualifications (SOQ); and

WHEREAS, eight (8) firms met or exceeded the City Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirements and were considered for further evaluation; and

WHEREAS, two (2) firms did not meet the City (LBE/SLBE) requirement and were deemed non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, the eight (8) firms were evaluated by a panel of three (3) professionals with experience in the scope of services and project types identified in the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, based on panel's evaluation, contract requirements, and assessment of Division needs, seven (7) firms have been selected for recommendation to be awarded with professional services agreements to provide on-call construction management services; and

WHEREAS, on-call construction management services will be funded through the various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the on-call services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the contracts authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature and are temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the contracts shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorize the City Administrator to execute a total of seven (7) Professional Services Agreement Contracts with On-Call Construction Management (CM) Services, in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) each with: 1) Acumen Building Services, Inc., 2) AGS, Inc.,3) Biggs Cardosa Associates Inc., 4) Consolidated CM, 5) Ghirardelli & Associates 6) Kal Krishnan Consulting Services, Inc., and 7) VSCE, Inc.; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the total amount of the Contract for each firm shall be for a not-to-exceed amount of \$750,000; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the terms of each Contract shall be for three (3) years and are anticipated to cover the time period from March 2019 to March 2022; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said Contracts with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation or the allocation of funds, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Contracts shall be approved for form and legality by the City Attorney, and a copy shall be kept on file with the City Clerk.
