RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator, Or Designee, To:

- 1) Award A Contract In The Amount Of Six Hundred Nineteen Thousand Dollars (\$619,000.00) To Saboo, Inc., The Lowest Responsive And Responsible Bidder, For The Construction Of The Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (Project No. 1003442), In Accordance With The Project Plans And Specifications And Contractor's Bid; And
- 2) Approve And Reallocate Funds In The Amount Of Four Hundred Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$435,000.00) From Head Start Playground Replacement Project (No. 1003444) -Measure KK Bond Fund (5330) To The Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project For **Construction And Project Contingency.**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of this resolution will award and execute a construction contract with the low bidder. Saboo Incorporated in the amount of six hundred nineteen thousand dollars (\$619,000.00). The project is located in Council District 7 as shown in Attachment A.

Additionally, approval will reallocate total funds in the amount of four hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$435,000.00) from the Head Start Playground Replacement Project (No. 1003444), to the Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (Project No. 1003442) for construction and project contingency.

The City issued a Notice of Inviting Bids for the Brookfield Head Start Renovation project on February 1, 2019 with three bids received on March 7, 2019. One bid is non-responsive due to incomplete mandatory Bid items and sub-contractor not being registered with the Department of Industrial Relations.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

In November 2016, the Measure KK General Obligation Bond was approved by the voters of Oakland to fund \$600 million of vital infrastructure improvements and Anti-Displacement and Affordable Housing Projects. On May 30, 2017, staff recommended to Council the Fiscal Year 2017-19 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), including projects proposed to be funded with Measure KK bond funds. On June 19, 2019 the City Council approved this list of projects for bond funding in Resolution No. 86773 C.M.S. On August 1, 2017, the Measure KK, Series 2017A-1 General Obligation Bond (the "Bond") was funded in the amount of \$62.735 million, of which \$375,000.00 was allocated to the Brookfield Head Start Classroom Renovation Project and \$480,000.00 was allocated to the Head Start Playground Replacement Project (No. 1003444). These funds were appropriated in the FY 2017-19 budget in Fund 5330 for the two projects.

The initial scope of work for the Brookfield Head Start Renovation was to replace windows and frames around the entire building, replace skylights above the classroom and repair and upgrade the electrical system. During the planning phase of the Brookfield Head Start Renovation-project, additional-scope-was-identified-including: add-two-exterior-doors-from-the-classroom to the newly renovated exterior play yard; add climate/heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) improvements; provide American's with Disability Act (ADA) improvements by converting one toddler restroom to gender neutral use, add a designated ADA parking space; and address potential repair of exterior wall due to water damage during construction.

Though existing funding through the Measure KK fund was insufficient to cover the additional scope, it was determined that those items would be incorporated and implemented as essential improvements. To address potential additional fund needs to cover the necessary additional scope, Department of Human Services (DHS) identified existing internal funds to pay for the Playground Renovations Projects (Project No. 1003444), enabling the Measure KK funds allocated for the Playground project to fund the additional renovation scope at the Brookfield facility.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

The Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (No. 1003442) was advertised for bid on February 1, 2019. Notifications were distributed by several means:

- the City of Oakland *iSupplier* system which includes City certified firms, registered General Contractors, plan rooms and builder's exchange, totaling over 300 notices
- printed legal notice in the Oakland Tribune, Daily Pacific Builder, El Mundo, Oakland Post, The Korea Times and the World Journal publications
- posting on CIPlist.com, which distributes to registered plan rooms and builders' exchanges

On March 7, 2019, the City Clerk received three bids from general contractors for the Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project as shown on *Attachment B*: Bid Summary (March 7, 2019), and as shown below:

Bid Analysis:

The Oakland Public Works Contract Services Division deemed two bidders as non-responsive with the City's Mandatory Bid Process. Bay Construction did not submit Schedule O and Mar Con Builders is not registered with the Department of Industrial Relations.

The City Administrator's Office, Contracts and Compliance Department deemed one bidder as compliant with the City's local business enterprise program as shown on *Attachment C:* Compliance Analysis, dated March 21, 2019. Saboo, Inc. exceeded the minimum Local/Small Local Business Enterprises (L/SLBE) participation requirement and is Equal Benefit Ordinance (EBO) compliant. Under the proposed contract with Saboo, Inc., the L/SLBE participation will be 50.97 percent.

Funding Status:

Existing available Project funding from the Measure KK award is insufficient to meet the construction budget. Knowing that there would likely be a shortfall, staff worked with the Department of Human Services (DHS) to identify additional funding to be made available to complete the Head Start Renovation projects. The Head Start Playground Renovation Project (No. 1003444) was completed in October 2018. DHS funded the playgrounds construction by utilizing Departmental funds available for improvements which help preserve a majority of the allocated Measure KK funds. Therefore, staff is requesting that the remaining Measure KK

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allocated funds for the Playground project, a total of \$435,000.00, be reallocated for the construction of the Head Start Facility renovation projects at Brookfield Recreation Center (No. 1003442). If approved, the construction is anticipated to begin during summer 2019 and be completed in approximately 6 months after the Notice-to-Proceed.

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

Prior to the start of construction, the neighboring residents and establishments affected by the work will be notified regarding the construction activities and project contact information. Temporary construction fencing and protective mitigation measures shall be implemented to minimize disruptions to the public and operations at the Brookfield Head Start Facility. Department of Human Services (DHS) staff will notify families utilizing the Brookfield facility, and provide alternate locations to accommodate users during construction.

COORDINATION

The work to be done under this contract has been coordinated with Oakland DHS, and appropriate divisions within the Public Works Department and Contract and Compliance Department.

This report and the resolutions have been reviewed for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney, the Budget Bureau, and Contract & Compliance Department of the City Administrator's Office.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: This project replaces damaged and aged City infrastructure. The consultant is verified for Local Business Enterprise and Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) participation by the Contract & Compliance Department of the City Administrator's Office. The construction services provided by local firms will result in dollars being spent locally. The contractors are required to have 50 percent of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50 percent of all new hires are to be Oakland residents, which will result in funds being spent locally.

Environmental: The contractor is required to comply with the City's Waste Recycling and Reuse Plan (WRRP). Best Management Practices shall be required to prevent storm water runoff from the jobsite during construction.

Social Equity: Brookfield Head Start is in an area of high ethnic diversity, low income, and limited English speaking constituencies. Improvements to the existing facility and assets will improve and expand opportunities for the community and all program users of City's Head Start facilities. The project will meet ADA requirements to provide equitable access for those who have mobility constraints.

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ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Administrator, or designee, to 1) award and execute a construction contract in the amount of six hundred nineteen thousand dollars (\$619,000.00) with Saboo, Inc. for the construction of the Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (No. 1003442), in accordance with the project plans and specifications; and 2) approve and reallocate funds in the amount of four hundred thirty five thousand dollars (\$435,000.00) from Head Start Playground Replacement Project (No. 1003444) - Measure KK Bond Fund (5330) to the Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (Project No. 1003442) for construction and project contingency.

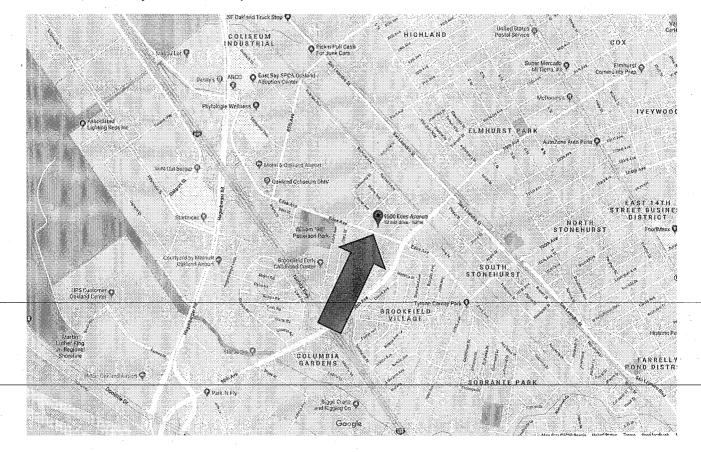
A: Project Location Map

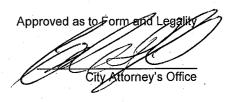

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO 1) AWARD A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF SIX HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$619,000.00) TO SABOO, INC., THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE AND RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BROOKFIELD HEAD START RENOVATION PROJECT (NO. 1003442), IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROJECT PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND CONTRACTOR'S BID; AND 2) APPROVE AND REALLOCATE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$435,000.00) FROM HEAD START PLAYGROUND REPLACEMENT PROJECT (NO. 1003444) - MEASURE KK BOND FUND (5330) TO THE BROOKFIELD HEAD START RENOVATION PROJECT FOR CONSTRUCTION AND PROJECT CONTINGENCY.

WHEREAS, Brookfield Head Start Renovation project is one of 18 facilities projects funded by the first series of Measure KK – Affordable Housing and Infrastructure Bond in Fall 2017; and

WHEREAS, The City issued a Notice of Inviting Bids for the Brookfield Head Start Renovation project on February 1, 2019 with three bids received on March 7, 2019; and

WHEREAS, Saboo Inc. is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the project; and

WHEREAS, Existing available Project funding from Measure KK award is insufficient to meet the construction budget; and

WHEREAS, Remaining funds in the amount of Four Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$435,000.00) are available for reallocation from the Head Start Playground Replacement Project (No. 1003444), to the Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (Project No. 1003442) for construction and project contingency; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines based on the representations set forth in the City Administrator's report accompanying this Resolution that the construction contract approved hereunder is temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work, that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy or better performance; and

WHEREAS, Saboo Inc. complies with all Local Business Enterprise/Small Local Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is authorized to award a construction contract to Saboo, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of six hundred nineteen thousand dollars (\$619,000.00) for the construction of the Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (No. 1003442), in accordance with the contractor's bid and the project plans and specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance bond, \$619,000.00 and the bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials_furnished_and_for_the_amount_under_the_Unemployment_Insurance_Act, \$619,000.00, with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Saboo, Inc, on behalf of the City of Oakland and to execute any amendments or modifications of the contract within the limits of the project specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared for this project, including any subsequent changes during construction, that will be reviewed and adopted by the Director, or designee, are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or Designee, is authorized to approve and reallocate funds in the amount of four hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$435,000.00) from Head Start Playground Replacement Project (No. 1003444) - Measure KK Bond Fund (5330) to the Brookfield Head Start Renovation Project (No. 1003442) for construction; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to reject all other bids; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality prior to execution and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
