An Overview of the City Budget Process


Together with the County,
State, and Federal
governments, the City of
Oakland is one of many
government agencies that
deliver services every day
to make our lives better.
From maintaining our roads,
sewers, and parks to providing
education, transit, and clean
water, local government is here
to serve the public.

During the city budget cycle, the City estimates its revenues (i.e., income) and expenditures (i.e., expenses) for two years. A budget cycle for the City of Oakland is a two-year period of time that includes an evaluation of the City's fiscal health, budget preparation, approval, and implementation.

While other cities and government agencies have different "cycles," Oakland approves a budget every two fiscal years. A Fiscal Year spans July 1 through June 30.

THE GOAL:

A BALANCED BUDGET

From February to June, every other year, City staff, the Mayor, and City Council work together to create a balanced budget by June 30 as required by law. A balanced budget is a plan to ensure that the City's revenues equal our expenses. The creation of a balanced budget plan happens in three phases: development, deliberation, and approval. See reverse side for a timeline by phase.

APRIL

The Mayor engages the public through town hall meetings and social media to answer budget questions and garner community insights.

BUDGET DELIBERATION | MAY

The City Council engages the public through town hall meetings, budget hearings, and social media to hear community insights and impacts.

MAY 1

Mayor releases Proposed FY 2019-21 Budget to public

MAY 7

The Mayor and City Administrator formally present the Proposed Budget to the City Council.

Budget is adopted as required by the City Charter.
