RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Establishing A Three Year Prioritization Plan For The City Of Oakland's Paving Program (2019-2021); And

A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator Or Designee To Award All Paying Construction Contracts That Follow All City Advertising and Competitive Bidding Requirements And Are Awarded In Direct Service Of Delivering The 2019 Three Year Prioritization Plan, Without Return To Council.

REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

This report is in response to a request by the Public Works Committee at its meeting on April 23, 2019. Staff was asked to provide additional information on the racial and ethnic breakdown of each Planning Area in the proposed 3-Year Paving Plan. Additionally, staff have provided an updated plan map which reflects corrected place names (Attachment A).

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

This supplemental report provides more specific data on the breakdown in each Planning Area by race and ethnicity (Table 1). This table specifically provides more information on the "Percent People of Color" metric which was used with other demographic information staff combined into two metrics (street condition and underserved populations) by planning area. These metrics were used to produce a weighting factor that incorporated both equity and street condition, which was used to distribute 85% of the \$75M local streets program, or \$63.8M.
