

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER [IF APPLICABLE]

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO WAIVE THE ADVERTISING AND BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR AWARD OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT TO THE EAST BAY BICYCLE COALITION (DBA BIKE EAST BAY) IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) TO CONDUCT BICYCLIST SAFETY EDUCATION CLASSES

WHEREAS, O.M.C. § 2.04.040.B.2 requires staff to conduct an informal advertising and competitive bid process for professional services when the expenditure ranges from \$500 to \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, O.M.C.§ 2.04.050.I.5 permits the City Council to waive such advertising and competitive bidding upon a finding that it is in the best interest of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council waive advertising and competitive bidding in this instance because Bike East Bay is the established leader in bicycle safety training classes throughout Alameda County, and provides the City of Oakland's classes in coordination with additional classes funded by the Alameda Transportation Commission; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council finds and determines that, pursuant to O.M.C. § 2.04.050.I.5 and for the reasons stated above and in the accompanying report, it is in the best interests of the City to waive advertising and the competitive bidding requirements of the O.M.C. for the award of a professional services agreement to the East Bay Bicycle Coalition (dba Bike East Bay), and so waives the requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator or designee is hereby authorized to approve a professional services agreement to provide bicyclist safety training classes in Oakland in an amount not-to-exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00).
