WHEREAS, the City of Oakland's sidewalk infrastructure is considered a significant asset that impacts the quality of life for those who live and work in Oakland; and

WHEREAS, areas of sidewalk damage present accessibility challenges for Oaklanders who use wheelchairs, strollers, or other mobility devices; and

WHEREAS, areas of sidewalk damage can lead to injuries which can result in claims and lawsuits; and

WHEREAS, approximately 85% of sidewalk damage in Oakland is the responsibility of a private property owner to repair; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland wishes to increase the number of annual voluntary sidewalk damage repairs performed by property owners; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland wishes to incentivize all property owners to repair sidewalk damage by temporarily reducing permit fees; and

WHEREAS, in establishing this program, the City of Oakland will support the improved condition of sidewalk infrastructure in Oakland; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Department of Transportation is authorized to temporarily waive administrative permit fees for sidewalk repair of all property owners for a period beginning July 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2019
