WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed Brian Beveridge (Oakland Works), Danny Lau (City Representative), Megan Morodomi (Employer Representative) Kate O'Hara (Revive Oakland Representative), Art Shanks (Job Training Representative) and Len Turner (Employer Representative) subject to confirmation by the City Council; now, therefore, be it
