RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO INCREASE SPENDING AUTHORITY FOR ADVANCE CRIME SCENE RESTORATION, FOR REMOVAL OF BIOHAZARDS, CONTAMINANTS AND PHYSICAL HAZARDS FROM CITY VEHICLES AND PROPERTY, BY ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000) FOR THE PERIOD OF NOVEMBER 1, 2017 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, it is essential for the safety of City employees as well as members of the public that all biohazards, contaminants and physical hazards be properly removed and disposed of from City vehicles and property; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 68570 C.M.S., approved by the City Council on December 17, 1991 authorizes the sole source procurement of hazardous substance removal and disposal services whenever the health and safety of the public is deemed to be in jeopardy as determined by the Oakland Police Department (OPD) or Fire Department (OFD); and

WHEREAS, Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 2.04 allows for the City Administrator to contract for professional services without City Council authority for amounts up to \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has a contract with Advance Crime Scene Restoration (ACSR) for \$250,000 for the period of November 1, 2017 through October 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the OPD and Oakland Public Works (OPW) are expected to exceed the existing contract amount with ACSR of \$250,000 prior to the contract end date of October 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$100,000 in spending authority is necessary to ensure that hazard abatement services for OPD, OFD and OPW can continue to be performed through October 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient budget in OPD and OPW's accounts to cover the cost of future invoices related to the removal of biohazards, contaminants and physical

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, or designee, to increase spending authority for ACSR, for removal of biohazards, contaminants and physical hazards, by one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for a total contract amount not to exceed three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) for the period of November 1, 2017 through October 31, 2019; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the agreement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That in accordance with Article IV, Section 401(6) of the City Charter, the contract authorized by this resolution shall be approved by as to form and legality before execution, and a copy of the fully executed agreement shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.
