INTRODUCED BY VICE MAYOR LARRY REID

RESOLUTION COMMEMORATIVELY RENAMING "A" STREET BETWEEN 85th and 86th AVENUES REV. DR. J. ALFRED SMITH SR. WAY WHICH FOLLOWS THE PROCESS OUTLINED AND ESTABLISHED BY RESOLUTION No. 77967 C.M.S.

WHEREAS, under the procedures outlined by the companion Resolutions No.77966 and 77967 the City Council may commemorate a nominee either by: a) retaining the existing street name and installing commemorative plaques or b) renaming the existing street for the individual and installing new street signs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in 2003 established procedures for commemorative street naming through Resolution No. 77967 C.M.S under which the City Council may, by its own motion, consider the renaming of a public street as a tribute to an individual, or as a result of a significant event or activity and one of the following conditions is met:
• the individual has positively impacted the lives of a nation or the world; or • the name change is related to an economic development or redevelopment activity; or • the renaming commemorates a significant historical event; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Vice Mayor Larry Reid finds that the life and legacy of Dr. J. Alfred Smith Sr., should be honored and recognized as established by Res. No 77967 in that Reverend Smith was called to the ministry in 1951, received his B.S. degree in Elementary Education from Western Baptist College, and Bachelor's Degree in divinity in 1959, Master's Degree in Theology, in 1966. Second master's degree in American Church History in 1972, and Doctor of Ministry Degree in 1975.

Reverend Smith was named senior pastor of Allen Temple Baptist Church in Oakland, California's in 1971, elected president of the Progressive Baptist State Convention of California in 1979 Reverend Smith has received several awards and honors for his outstanding work.

Dr. Smith is nationally known for his community work in Oakland, the Greater Bay Area and international delegations to address health needs in third world countries.
