RECOMMENDATION

Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator, Or Designee, To Award A Contract In The Amount Of Seven Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand and Six Hundred Dollars (\$798,600.00) To S&H Construction, Inc., The Lowest Responsive And Responsible Bidder, For The Construction Of The Fire Station #12 Remodel Project (Project No. 1003439A), In Accordance With The Project Plans And Specifications And Contractor's Bid.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of this proposed resolution will award and execute a construction contract with the lowest bidder, S&H Construction Incorporated in the amount of seven hundred ninety-eight thousand and six hundred dollars (\$798,600.00) for the renovation of Fire Station No. 12 located at 822 Alice Street. The project is located in Council District 2 as shown in *Attachment A*. The City issued a Notice of Inviting Bids for the Fire Station #12 Remodel project on September 16, 2019, with four bids received on October 10, 2019.

BACKGROUND / LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

In November 2016 Measure KK General Obligation Bond was approved by the voters of Oakland to fund \$600 million of vital infrastructure improvements and Anti-Displacement and Affordable Housing Projects. On May 30, 2017 staff recommended to City Council in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-19 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), projects proposed to be funded with Measure KK bond funds. On June 19, 2019 the City Council approved this list of projects for bond funding in Resolution No. 86773 C.M.S. On August 1, 2017, the Measure KK, Series 2017A-1 General Obligation Bond (the "Bond") was funded in the amount of \$62.735 million, of which \$3.0 million was allocated for the Fire Stations Citywide Renovations-Top Four Priority Stations. The fund was appropriated in the FY 2017-19 budget in Fund 5330.

The project is the first priority station and the scope of work consists of renovation of the dormitories and restroom areas at Fire Station No. 12 located at 822 Alice Street. The work includes, but is not limited to, selected demolition and the addition of new partitions, casework,

finishes and modifications of existing mechanical, electrical, plumbing, fire alerting and fire protection systems to approximately 705 gross square feet of existing space. Work also includes alterations to accessible path of travel from building entrance to project area, including alterations to exterior metal man gate, exterior concrete walkway to main entry and changes to interior doors and opening.

ANALYSIS AND POLICY ALTERNATIVES

The Fire Station #12 Remodel Project (No. 1003439) was advertised for bid on September 16, 2019. Notifications were distributed by several means:

- the City of Oakland *iSupplier* system, which includes City certified firms, registered General Contractors, plan rooms and builder's exchange, totaling over 300 notices
- printed legal notice in the East Bay Times, Daily Pacific Builder, El Mundo, Oakland Post, The Korea Times and the World Journal publications
- posting on CIPlist.com, which distributes to registered plan rooms and builders' exchanges

On October 10, 2019, the City Clerk received four bids from general contractors for the Fire Station Remodel Project as shown on *Attachment B*: Bid Summary (October 11, 2019), and as shown below:

Bid Analysis

The Oakland Public Works Contract Services Division deemed all bidders were responsive with the City's Mandatory Bid Process.

The City Administrator's Office, Contracts and Compliance Department reviewed four (4) bids and deemed three (3) bidders as compliant with the City's local business enterprise program as shown on *Attachment C:* Compliance Analysis, dated October 18, 2019. S&H Construction, Inc., the lowest bidder exceeded the minimum Local/Small Local Business Enterprises (L/SLBE) participation requirement and is Equal Benefit Ordinance (EBO) compliant. Under the proposed contract with S&H Construction, Inc., the L/SLBE participation will be 50.8 percent.

Approval of this resolution will authorize the City Administrator to execute a construction contract in the amount of \$798,600.00.

PUBLIC OUTREACH / INTEREST

Prior to the start of construction, the neighboring residents and establishments affected by the work will be notified regarding the construction activities and project contact information. Temporary construction fencing and protective mitigation measures shall be implemented to minimize disruptions to the public. The Fire Station #12 will be temporarily closed for four months, and staff will be relocated and be operating at a nearby facility during construction.

COORDINATION

The work to be done under this contract has been coordinated with Oakland Fire Department and appropriate divisions within the Public Works Department and Contract and Compliance Department.

This report and the resolutions have been reviewed for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and the Budget Bureau of the City Administrator's Office.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: This project replaces damaged and aged City infrastructure. The contractor is verified for Local Business Enterprise and Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) participation by the Contract & Compliance Department of the City Administrator's Office. The construction services provided by local firms will result in dollars being spent locally. The contractors are required to have 50 percent of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50 percent of all new hires are to be Oakland residents, which will result in funds being spent locally.

Environmental: The contractor is required to comply with the City's Waste Recycling and Reuse Plan (WRRP). Best Management Practices shall be required to prevent storm water runoff from the jobsite during construction.

Race & Equity: Fire Station #12 is in an area of high ethnic diversity, low income, and limited English speaking constituencies. Improvements to the existing facility and assets will provide densely populated community and diverse. The project will meet ADA requirements to provide equitable access for those who have mobility constraints.

Staff recommends that City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Administrator, or designee, to 1) award and execute a construction contract in the amount of seven hundred ninety-eight hundred thousand and six hundred dollars (\$798,600.00) with S&H Construction, Inc. for the construction of the Fire Station #12 Remodel Project (No. 1003439), in accordance with the project plans and specifications.



AWARD AND EXECUTE TO A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY EIGHT THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$798,600.00) TO CONSTRUCTION, INC., THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE FIRE STATION #12 REMODEL PROJECT (NO. 1003439A), IN ACCORDANCE **PLANS** AND WITH THE PROJECT **SPECIFICATIONS** CONTRACTOR'S BID.

WHEREAS, Fire Station #12 Remodel project is one of 4 facilities projects funded by the first series of Measure KK - Affordable Housing and Infrastructure Bond in Fall 2017; and

WHEREAS, The City issued a Notice of Inviting Bids for the Fire Station #12 Remodel project on September 16, 2019 with four bids received on October 10, 2019; and

WHEREAS, S&H Construction Inc. is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it
