This letter is to provide an update on the resolution of the dispute resolution process, which was initiated on July 10, 2018. The initiation of a dispute resolution occurred due to the dispute surrounding the exclusive rights to operate a bikeshare program in the City of Oakland, specifically regarding dockless bicycles and ebikes. OakDOT agreed to postpone the dispute process due to the regional ebike discussion currently underway. As both parties know, four out of seven parties have signed a letter, setting forth the parameters of an ebike expansion of the program, consistent with the terms of the original 2015 Program and Coordination Agreement. Once the City of Oakland signs the current ebike letter, MTC considers the dispute to be resolved.
