Staff Recommends That The City Council Adopt The Following Pieces Of Legislation:

- 1) Resolution Authorizing The City To Apply For, Accept And Appropriate Loan And Grant Funds Under The State Of California's 2018-2019 Affordable Housing And Sustainable Communities Program For The Fruitvale Transit Village IIB Project Located At 35th Avenue And East 12th Street, In An Amount Not To Exceed \$30,000,000, And Authorize Agreements With BART And AC Transit For Transportation-Related Improvements; And
- 2) Resolution Authorizing The City To Apply For, Accept And Appropriate Loan And Grant Funds Under The State Of California's 2018-2019 Affordable Housing And Sustainable Communities Program For The Mandela Station Project At West Oakland Bart Station, In An Amount Not To Exceed \$30,000,000, And Authorize Agreements With BART And AC Transit For Transportation-Related Improvements.
