RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE EMERGENCY **RESPONSE TO INTERPERSONAL VIOLENCE – 2020 PANDEMIC GRANT FUNDS ADMINISTERED BY THE CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY** CENTERS OF CALIFORNIA (CACC), IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000), FOR THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY 24, 2020 THROUGH JULY 31, 2020, TO PURCHASE COMPUTERS FOR THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT (OPD) SPECIAL VICTIMS SECTION (SVS), PURCHASE TEMPORARY SHELTER FOR VICTIMS OF CHILD ABUSE AND THEIR FAMILIES, AND FUND MISCELLANEOUS EXPENSES INCURRED BY SVS IN SUPPORT OF CHILD ABUSE VICTIMS IMPACTED BY THE CORONA VIRUS PANDEMIC.

WHEREAS, the Children's Advocacy Centers of California (CACC) is a California membership organization dedicated to helping local communities respond to allegations of child abuse and efficiently put the needs of child victims first; and

WHEREAS, CACC was selected by the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) to offer funding to organizations and agencies serving abused children during the current Corona Virus Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, OPD applied for and received a sixty-thousand-dollar (\$60,000) grant from CACC to support the Special Victims Section's work with abused children impacted by the Corona Virus Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, OPD plans to use grant funds to: 1) purchase computers that directly support the work of SVS personnel; and 2) purchase temporary shelter for victims of child abuse and their families; as well as to support miscellaneous expenses, and

WHEREAS, CACC grant fund rules require grant funds to be accepted, appropriated, and spent by July 31, 2020; now, therefore, be it

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RESOLVED: that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or designee to accept and appropriate the grant award from CACC/Child Abuse Listening, Interviewing and Coordination Center (CALICO) in the amount of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that grant appropriations will be allocated to the State of California Office of Emergency Services Grant Fund (2146); Special Victims Section (102130); Project (TBD); Criminal Investigations Program (PS03); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the agreement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that all contracts issued hereunder shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality and copies shall be placed on file in the City Clerk's Office.
