AN ORDINANCE AMENDING OAKLAND MUNICI-PAL CODE, CHAPTER 15.24, ENTITLED EARTH-QUAKE DAMAGED STRUCTURES, DELEGATING TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE THE AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH AN ADMINIS-TRATIVE REGULATORY PROGRAM FOR ABATE-MENT AND UPGRADE OF EARTHQUAKE DAM-AGED STRUCTURES, WHICH PROGRAM MAY BE UPDATED AS NEEDED IN RESPONSE TO CHANGES IN LAWS, CODES, OR LOCAL CIR-CUMSTANCES
