ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SALARY SCHED-ULE OF ORDINANCE NO. 12187 C.M.S. ("SAL-ARY ORDINANCE") TO PROVIDE A WAGE IN-CREASE TO REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES IN REP-RESENTATION UNITS TA1, TF1, TM2, TW1, UH1, UM1, UM2, TM1, AND U41 PURSUANT TO THE TENTATIVE AGREEMENT TO THE MEMORAN-DUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND THE INTERNATIONAL FED-ERATION OF PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL ENGINEERS, LOCAL 21; THE WAGE INCREASE SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS: AN INCREASE OF 1% EFFECTIVE THE FIRST FULL PAY PERIOD FOL-LOWING JANUARY 1, 2020.

This Ordinance will provide a wage increase to the classifications listed in the current Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Oakland and the International Federation of Technical and Professional Engineers (IFPTE), Local 21 as follows: an increase of one percent (1 %) effective the first full pay period following January 1, 2020.
