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**A RESOLUTION :**

- 1. TO ALLOCATE \$277,348 IN MEASURE Q (2020 OAKLAND PARKS AND RECREATION PRESERVATION, LITTER REDUCTION, AND HOMELESSNESS SUPPORT ACT) FUNDS FOR FY 2020-2021 FOR THE PROVISION OF PERMANENT HOUSING SUBSIDIES AND SUPPORTIVE SERVICES TO HOMELESS FAMILIES PARTICIPATING IN THE OAKLAND PATH REHOUSING INITIATIVE (OPRI) PROGRAM; AND**
- 2. TO AWARD A GRANT TO BUILDING FUTURES WITH WOMEN AND CHILDREN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,405,948 FOR FY 2020-2021 FOR THE PROVISION OF PERMANENT HOUSING SUBSIDIES AND SUPPORT SERVICES FOR HOMELESS FAMILIES UNDER OPRI.**

**WHEREAS,** Oakland City Council Resolution No. 79923 C.M.S., passed on May 30, 2006, authorized the development and implementation of the City of Oakland's Permanent Access To Housing (PATH) Strategy to end homelessness; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the PATH strategy, Oakland Housing Authority (OHA) has partnered with the City since July 2010 to implement the Oakland PATH Re-Housing Initiative (OPRI) to fund rental housing subsidies for homeless individuals living in encampments or on the streets, youths exiting foster care or juvenile justice systems, and young adults who are at high risk of being perpetrators or victims of violence; and

**WHEREAS,** Oakland City Council Resolution No. 87698 C.M.S. authorized, among other things, the continued implementation of the OPRI program for Fiscal Years (FY) 19-20 and 20-21, including the City's authorization to accept and appropriate additional funds that become available from OHA for the OPRI program within the grant terms of FY 19-20 and FY 20-21; and

**WHEREAS,** OHA increased its grant to the City for FY 20-21 to expand the program to serve 40 unsheltered families with housing subsidies; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Oakland voters passed the 2020 Oakland Parks and Recreation Preservation, Litter Reduction, and Homelessness Support Act (Measure Z) in March 2020, approving a parcel tax to support parks and recreation, water quality, and homelessness services; and

**WHEREAS,** Oakland City Council Resolution No. 88174 C.M.S., passed on June 23, 2020, made mid-cycle adjustments to the City's biennial budget, including but not limited to budgeting \$3,987,212 in FY20-21 for third party grants for homeless services, subject to Council approval, which was appropriated in the Measure Q Fund (2244), Community Housing Services Organization (78411), Account (TBD), Project (TBD), Fostering Safe and Healthy Communities Program (SC22); and

**WHEREAS**, the City seeks to allocate \$277,348 in Measure Q homelessness funding to help provide approximately 40 unsheltered families in the OPRI program with permanent housing subsidies and supportive services for FY 20-21; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires, using the additional, previously-appropriated OHA funds that the City expects to receive and accept for FY 20-21, as authorized by Resolution No. 87698 C.M.S., combined with the Measure Q funds allocated by this resolution, to award a grant to Building Futures for Women and Children (BFWC) in an amount not to exceed \$1,405,948 for FY 20-21 for permanent housing subsidies and supportive services for homeless families in the OPRI program, so long as said grant award amount does not exceed the cumulative total of the additional available OHA funds the City actually receives and accepts for FY 20-21, combined with the available Measure Q funds authorized by this resolution; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby allocates \$277,348 in Measure Q homelessness funding to provide approximately 40 unsheltered families in the OPRI program with permanent housing subsidies and supportive services for FY 20-21; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City, using the additional, previously-appropriated OHA funds that the City expects to receive and accept for FY 20-21 as authorized by Resolution No. 87698 C.M.S., combined with the Measure Q funds allocated by this resolution, hereby awards a grant to BFWC in an amount not to exceed \$1,405,948 for FY 20-21 for permanent housing subsidies and supportive services for homeless families in the OPRI program, so long as said grant award amount does not exceed the cumulative total of the additional available OHA funds the City actually receives and accepts for FY 20-21, combined with the available Measure Q funds authorized by this resolution; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to negotiate, submit and execute all documents, including, but not limited to, applications, contracts, grant agreements, amendments, payment requests, reports, and to take all related actions necessary to carry out the foregoing for FY 20-21, without returning to Council; and be it,

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the above agreement shall be reviewed and approved by the Office of the City Attorney for form and legality prior to execution and executed copies placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
