RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY VACATING A PORTION OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY OF KING STREET FROM 5 FEET SOUTH OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH DENNISON STREET TO 68.6 FEET NORTH OF ITS INTERSECTION WITH FREDERICK STREET

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 8300 et seq., a public meeting was held in the Chamber of the Council of the City of Oakland, on the Third Floor of City Hall, at One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, in Oakland, California, on January 5, 2021, beginning at 1:30 p.m. local time to receive supporting evidence and public comments for a proposed resolution conditionally vacating a portion of the public right-of-way of King Street from 5 feet south of its intersection with Dennison Street to 68.6 feet north of its intersection with Frederick Street; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Sections 8312 and 8355, Duke Realty K&D LP, a Delaware limited partnership, owner of the adjacent property located at 955 Kennedy Street and 1905 Dennison Street Avenue ("Applicant") have filed an application (PPE 2000054) with the City Engineer of the City of Oakland and paid fees required by the Master Fee Schedule requesting that the Council of the City of Oakland vacate said portion of King Street, as delineated by the metes and bounds in Exhibit A, and shown in the maps attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, said vacation will close through traffic on King Street to improve neighborhood safety and health; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code section 65402, the City Planning Department has considered the partial vacation for conformity with the City's General Plan, and has determined that the location, purpose, and extent of the proposed vacation conform with the General Plan; and

WHEREAS, said land area proposed for vacation will be removed from the inventory of public streets maintained by the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets & Highways Code section 8348, the City Engineer has informed public utilities serving the property abutting King Street of the City's intention to vacate said portion of King Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that the proposed vacation of said portion of King Street will not adversely impact current or future traffic or pedestrian access to the adjoining and surrounding real properties; and

WHEREAS, the portion of King Street proposed for vacation is wholly located within the corporate limits of the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, as a separate and independent basis, the project is also exempt from CEQA review pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 1530; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Sections 8317, 8322, and 8323, facsimiles of the newspaper publication and public posting, attached hereto as *Exhibit C*, and an affidavit, attached as *Exhibit D*, confirm that the City Engineer completed the statutory requirements for notifying the public of the City's intention to vacate a portion of King Street and of the location, date, and time of public hearing to receive supporting evidence and public comments for the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code Section 8324, the Council of the City of Oakland may apply conditions for the vacation of public right-of-way and may instruct the City Clerk not to record a vacation until the conditions have been satisfied; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the vacation of a portion of King Street between Dennison Street and Frederick Street complies with requirements of CEQA; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the maps attached hereto as **Exhibit B** does fully delineate the metes and bounds of the section of public right-of-way proposed for vacation; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the conditional vacation of a portion of King Street between Dennison Street and Frederick Street, as delineated in *Exhibit A* and *Exhibit B* is hereby ordered; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That this order of vacation shall expire by limitation and become void in the event that the applicant and its representatives, heirs, successors, and assigns and successive owners of said vacated portion of King Street fail to complete the following required action below:

a. Within one (1) year following adoption of this resolution, complete public infrastructure construction under infrastructure permit number PX2000018 for the relocation of existing and the installation of new public infrastructure improvements, which include, but are not limited to, ADA curb ramp, fire hydrant relocation, streetlight removal and installation of street closure signs, sidewalk, curb, gutter, storm water catchments, roadway striping, traffic control devices, horizontal control monumentation; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code section 8325, this order of vacation shall not be complete unless and until this ordinance has been filed for recording with the Alameda County Clerk-Recorder.



