President Fortunato Bas and Members of the City Council:

Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled claim for the sum of Ninety Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars and Zero Cents (\$98,999.00), payable to Plaintiff Rebecca Reed-Lunn, through her attorneys, the law firm of Minami Tamaki LLP.

This action arises out of an alleged bicycle fall by Plaintiff Rebecca Reed-Lunn on July 9, 2018, near 77 Vernon Street in Oakland. Plaintiff alleges that she hit a roadway depression, which caused her to fall from her bicycle and suffer a fractured elbow and AC joint separation, requiring surgery. Plaintiff alleges a claim for dangerous condition on public property against the City of Oakland.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Thursday, January 21, 2021 (moved by Councilmember Rebecca Kaplan and seconded by Councilmember Sheng Thao - 7 Ayes, 0 Noes, 1 Absent – Councilmember Carroll Fife).
