RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO 1) WAIVE THE ADVERTISING/BIDDING AND **REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL/QUALIFICATIONS REQUIREMENTS, AND** 2) AWARD A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT CONTRACT TO THE CHILD ABUSE LISTENING, INTERVIEWING, AND COORDINATION CENTER (CALICO), TO PROVIDE FORENSIC INTERVIEWS, **MULTIDISCIPLINARY** CHILD ABUSE INVESTIGATIONS, FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES, COMMUNITY OUTREACH AND TRAINING, TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT (OPD) FOR THREE YEARS, FROM JULY 1, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022, FOR A SUM OF NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000), PLUS TWO DISCRETIONARY ONE-YEAR **EXTENSIONS AT THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000) PER YEAR,** FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000).

WHEREAS, CALICO plays an integral part in the Oakland Police Department's efforts to combat child abuse by minimizing the trauma to abused children, by improving coordination of child abuse case investigations, and supporting children and their families in receiving appropriate medical, legal, and therapeutic services; and

WHEREAS, CALICO projects to interview 600-700 children as well as developmentally delayed adults each year during this contract, with 25 to 30 percent of those youth and adults being Oakland residents; and

WHEREAS, CALICO annually requests funding from local police departments and has made such a request from the Oakland Police Department to support the organization with funding prorated based upon usage of services rendered; and

WHEREAS, a \$30,000 per year contract with CALICO will support its approximately \$800,000 annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Resolution No. 81778 C.M.S which approved a contract with CALICO for \$24,99 for FY 2008-09; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Resolution No. 82407 C.M.S which approved a contract with CALICO for \$22,500 for FY 2009-10; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Resolution No. 84494 C.M.S which approved a contract with CALICO for \$95,000 for FY 2010-15; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Resolution No. 85879 C.M.S which approved a contract with CALICO for \$30,000 per year for a total contract of \$120,000 for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, CALCO has collaborated with OPD during the Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-20 and FY 20-21 despite no current contract because of the urgent need to support child and developmentally delayed adult victim services; and

WHEREAS, funds have been identified in the General-Purpose Fund (1010), Special Victims Section (102130), Miscellaneous Contract Account (54919), Project (1000008), Criminal Investigations Program (PS03); and

WHEREAS, Oakland Municipal Code (OMC) Section 2.04.050.1.5 authorizes the City Council to waive the advertising and competitive bidding requirements of OMC Section 2.04.050 after a finding and determination that it is in the best interests of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the City Council make a finding and a determination that it is in the best interests of the City to waive advertising and bidding processes because CALICO is the only accredited child advocacy center serving Alameda County; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator, or designee, to waive the advertising/bidding and request for proposal/qualifications requirements because it is within the City's best interests to do so as CALICO is the only accredited child advocacy center serving Alameda County; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oakland City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator, or designee to award a professional services agreement contract to CALICO to provide forensic interviews, multidisciplinary child abuse investigations, family support services, community outreach and training to OPD for three years, from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022, for a sum of ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000), plus two discretionary one-year extensions at thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) per year, for a total contract not to exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that funds for the CALICO contract shall be paid from the General-Purpose Fund (1010), Special Victims Section (102130), Miscellaneous Contract Account (54919), Project (1000008), Criminal Investigations Program (PS03); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or their designee shall place a copy of the fully executed CALICO Agreement on file with the Office of the City Clerk; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is authorized to enter into a sole-source agreement with CALICO and complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend

this agreement for services, except for any increases in the Agreement Cap set forth herein, without returning to City Council; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall approve the agreement and contract terms as to form and legality.
