


Assault with a Firearm – 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020


Robbery - 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020






Assault with a Firearm – 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020



#### Assault with a Firearm – Full Year 2019








Robbery – 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020



## Area 1 Trends and Open Beat Projects

Identified trends of shootings during hours of 1700-0200hrs and prioritized visible patrols in the following areas.

- 1. 800-900 block of Filbert St.
- 2. 2100-2400 block of Market St.
- 3. Brockhurst and Filbert St.
- 4. 7<sup>th</sup> and Center St.
- 5. 32<sup>nd</sup> and San Pablo area

Opened beat project(s) regarding Blight and Narcotics with the focus of collaborative community problem-solving work to reduce issues surrounding our unhoused population.

### **Area 1 Special Resource Section Efforts**

- Street robberies in the downtown area were occurring during the hours of 0800-1600, M-F. We prioritized visible patrols along with an overtime detail. This resulted in a 31% overall robbery reduction.
- Centered main SRS efforts on coordinated investigations for homicide and shootings, along with thorough preliminary investigations and rapid sharing of criminal information for intel-led stops and arrests.
- Made risk management a related and necessary goal in line with crime reduction efforts such as pursuit mitigation and de-escalation, through continuous lune-up training and peer-to-peer mentoring on current techniques and best practices in line with Oakland Police Department values.








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#### Assault with a Firearm – Full Year 2019








Robbery – 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020




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Robbery – Full Year 2019

- Assaults with Firearms were associated to broader circumstances than seen in past trends associated with gang conflicts. Shootings occurred in Area 2 Beats not typically associated with shooting violence and within a variety of circumstances. Quality investigations and follow-up were prioritized for intel-led stops and arrests
- Collaborative problem-solving enacted when root cause circumstances could be identified: Gang conflict (Ceasefire strategies) and unhoused community conflicts (Outreach and resources requested)
- Robbery trends indicated huge decrease of street robberies and trend toward offenses occurring at retail establishments;
   Community Resource Officers opened projects with stores and community in response

## Area 2 – Areas of Focus (Cont.)

- Commercial burglary increase associated to unlawful acts of looting proximate to crowd control events.
- Primary preventative responses relied on strategy designed to minimize unrelated detentions and arrests, maximize intel-led stops and arrests, and provide visible and engaging security checks at locations suffering disproportionate impacts of criminal offenses
- Mitigation, de-escalation, and risk management prioritized as a related goal in crime reduction and prevention efforts.
- Reduced non-dispatched stops by 52% while only reducing total arrests by 1%



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




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Assault with a Firearm – Full Year 2019


Assault with a Firearm – Full Year 2020





Robbery – 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020






- Identified trends of shootings between 1900-0400 hours and prioritized visible patrols along the E.15<sup>th</sup> corridor (Beat 19). The violence stems mainly from prostitution, illegal gambling establishments and illegal narcotic sales.
- CRO's have open projects regarding the illegal activity (Prostitution, Illegal gambling, narcotic dealing, etc.) in this area (Beat 19). The Community (Schools, Churches, City Council, Residents) are all working with OPD to reduce the violence.
- Over 75 firearms were recovered from this area (14<sup>th</sup> Ave-23<sup>rd</sup> Ave and International-Foothill) during 2020. There were over 100 arrests made from this area ranging from illegal firearm charges, robbery and other violent crimes.
- SRS 3 authored 13 search warrants for illegal gambling establishments, recovered over \$100,000 and seized numerous illegal gaming machines.

# Area 3 – Areas of Focus (Cont)

- SRS 3 and SVU worked together to rescue the underage females from prostitution and had advocates on hand. They also arrested several males that were managing the prostitution in this area.
- SRS 3 worked with CID to identify the persons responsible for the violence and shared this information which produce intelled stops and arrests.
- SRS 3 took on the weekend activities located at Lake Merritt. They were there to educate and assist the citizens and to ensure safety. From April-November, they only arrested two people (one for robbery and one for drunk in public). They were commended by attendees, citizens in the area and other City of Oakland employees for their professionalism.
- During all of these incidents we made risk management a related and necessary goal in line with crime reduction efforts.




Robbery – 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020



Assault with a Firearm – Full Year 2019


Assault with a Firearm – Full Year 2020





ShotSpotter Activations – 01 Jul. to 31 Dec., 2020






