A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR:

- 1. TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) CHILD AND ADULT CARE FOOD PROGRAM (CACFP) GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN AN ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$249,723) TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR NUTRITIOUS MEALS FROM JULY 1, 2021 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022; AND
- 2. TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL CACFP GRANT FUNDING THAT BECOMES AVAILABLE FOR THE SAME PURPOSES BETWEEN JULY 1, 2021 AND JUNE 30, 2022 AND AMEND THE AGREEMENT WITHOUT RETURNING TO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland desires to apply for and accept a United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) Grant in an estimated amount of Two Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Three dollars (\$249,723) from the California Department of Education ("CDE") to fund a Head Start/Early Head Start child nutrition program from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-2022 Proposed Budget includes Two Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Three dollars\$249,723 in appropriations in the Department of Agriculture Fund (2102), HS Classroom and Seasonal Org (78231), Head Start FY21-22 CACFP Project (1005568), Strengthening Children, Youth & Families Program (YS13) for FY 2021-22 for the CACFP grant; and

WHEREAS, the CDE Child Nutrition and Distribution Division will provide funds for comprehensive nutrition services to approximately 226 Head Start and Early Head Start children, who have the most economic need, with ten percent of the enrollment consisting of children with special needs; now therefore, be it,

RESOLVED: That the City, by and through the City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to submit an application to the CDE for USDA CACFP funds to operate a Child Care Food Program for children enrolled in the Oakland Head Start and Early Head Start program

from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022, and to accept said funds in an estimated amount of \$249,723; and be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate any additional funding that may become available from this grantor (USDA), for the same purposes (CACFP), within the existing grant term, July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022, without returning to Council; and be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to conduct all negotiations, execute, and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests, and related actions which may be necessary to apply for, accept and appropriate the aforementioned grant; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said grant awards and sub-contract agreements shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
