RG20054133, IN THE AMOUNT OF TWELVE MILLION DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$12,000,000.00) ARISING FROM A JUNE 5, 2019 AUTO ACCIDENT INVOLVING AN OPD VEHICLE AT THE INTERSECTION OF LEMON STREET AND CURTOLA PARKWAY IN VALLEJO, CALIFORNIA; AND (2) AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INITIATE LEGAL ACTION AGAINST OAKLAND POLICE OFFICER MARCELL PATTERSON FOR INDEMNITY (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT – AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENT)

**WHEREAS,** an unmarked Oakland Police Department Ford Explorer collided with a Kia Forte driven by Terry Baker in the late evening of June 5, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Police Department vehicle was traveling at an estimated speed of 50 miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, the officer driving the Oakland Police Department vehicle was determined to be at fault for running a red light; and

WHEREAS, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG20054133 was filed against the City of Oakland and Officer Marcell Patterson alleging personal injury claims based upon negligence in operating a motor vehicle, including claims for permanent brain injury, multiple broken bones, and other serious injuries; and

**WHEREAS**, without admitting fault or wrongdoing, the City has determined to compromise Terry Baker's claim against it and Officer Patterson for the sum of Twelve Million Dollars and No Cents (\$12,000,000.00); now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of *Terry Baker v. City of Oakland, et al.*, Alameda County Superior Court Case No. RG20054133 for the sum of Twelve Million Dollars and No Cents (\$12,000,000.00); and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to initiate legal action against Oakland police officer Marcell Patterson for indemnity; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement.
